May they all rest in peace. We pray for all of those beginning their half-term break; may they enjoy the period of rest and return refreshed.

This Tuesday is the feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary to her cousin Elizabeth: the second of the Joyful Mysteries of the rosary and a mystery which I never find difficult to meditate upon. There is so much within the decision of Mary - newly pregnant with her divine son - to visit her cousin that inspires. My experience of the mystery was enhanced by having the privilege to visit the Holy Land and navigate the terrain (in the comfort of a coach) that she would have walked to reach the site of her cousin's house. The territory is undulating and difficult from Nazareth to the site called Ein Karem near Jerusalem (where it is believed Elizabeth lived with Zecariah) and - even traversing it in the comfort of a coach - is rather hairy. How must it have been for Mary? Contemplating such a journey - having experienced the apparition of the angel and the news of her new role as Mother of God - is in itself remarkable but the Gospel tells us that she set out "at once". The charitable impulse to do good for others was primary in Mary's experience and yet the nature of that charity is also in itself simple: visiting someone. We are not free from sin - as Mary was - and we struggle with being charitable yet there is always someone we can visit in love. Let us ask Mary to ask God to help us be ready to set out "at once" in visitation to whomever is in need of our presence and our love.

**OUR SUNDAY OBLIGATION:** During the heights of the pandemic, the Bishops of England & Wales released the faithful from the requirement to attend Mass on Sundays and other holy days of obligation. From <u>Pentecost Sunday (5 June)</u> the general requirement to attend Holy Mass in person is restored; in the words of the Bishops of England & Wales, "the reasons which have prevented Catholics from attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation no longer apply."

**PRIEST REFERENCE FORMS FOR SCHOOL APPLICATIONS:** Now that the Sunday obligation has been re-instated by the Bishops of England and Wales priest's reference forms will be completed in reference to forthcoming Church attendance. In order to ensure fairness and accuracy all parents who will be applying to Catholic schools for 2023 / 2024 entry (both primary and secondary) will - on certain Sundays during the year - be asked to register their presence with Fr Matthew after Mass. A guide on how you can register your family on our system will be included in next week's Newsletter.

**WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY**: This Sunday there is a Second Collection for the Catholic Communications Network which provides support to the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales in promoting the Gospel through the media.
