First-Rate Curriculum

School offers over 80 high school credit courses which can be chosen from Grade 9 to Grade 12. All our courses are based on the Ontario Secondary School curriculum. Students will be able to gain high school credits towards Ontario High School Diploma by completing their courses part time and full time basis.

To receive the Ontario Secondary School Diploma, students must:

Earn total 30 credits including 18 compulsory credits and 12 optional credits(minimum);



Complete 40 hours of community involvement activities;



Pass the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT) or the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Course (OLC40);

FOR ELEMENTARY ADMISSION: JK-G5

Applications are received by the Lower School throughout the year.

Interview

The admissions office will contact parents to arrange a mutually convenient time for an interview and tour of the school.

Try a Class

A JK-Grade 5 applicant will spend a morning in one of our classes (corresponding to the applicant's present grade). At some point during the morning, students will also be informally assessed by the head of our primary division.

Final Decision

Parents will receive our admission decision by a phone call and a follow-up letter within one week period.

FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL & High School ADMISSION: G6-G12

Applications are received by the G6 - G12 throughout the year.

Check the Study Record

Once a student has applied, Alathena will contact the applicants to submit the last three year's transcripts from the schools the student has attended and book an assessment date.

Assessment

A Grade 6-8 applicant will be formally assessed in the areas of reading, written expression, and mathematics

Final Decision

Applicants will receive our admission decision by a phone call and a follow-up letter within one week period.


PREPARATION FOR ARRIVAL CANADA
