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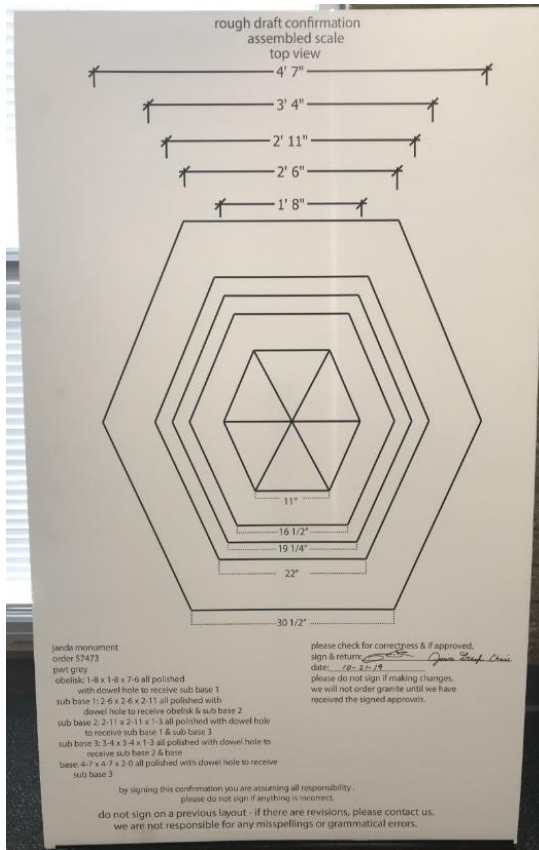

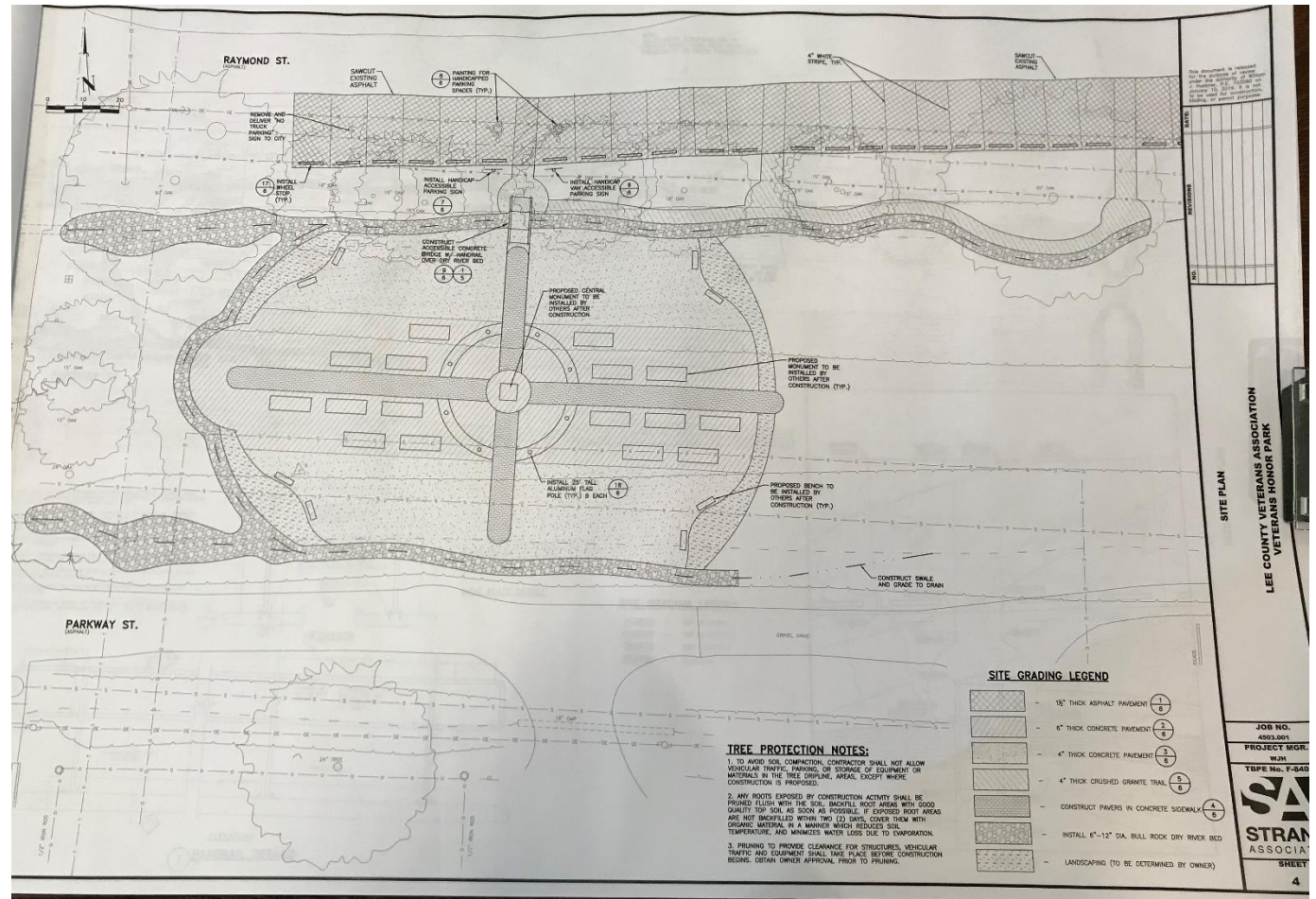

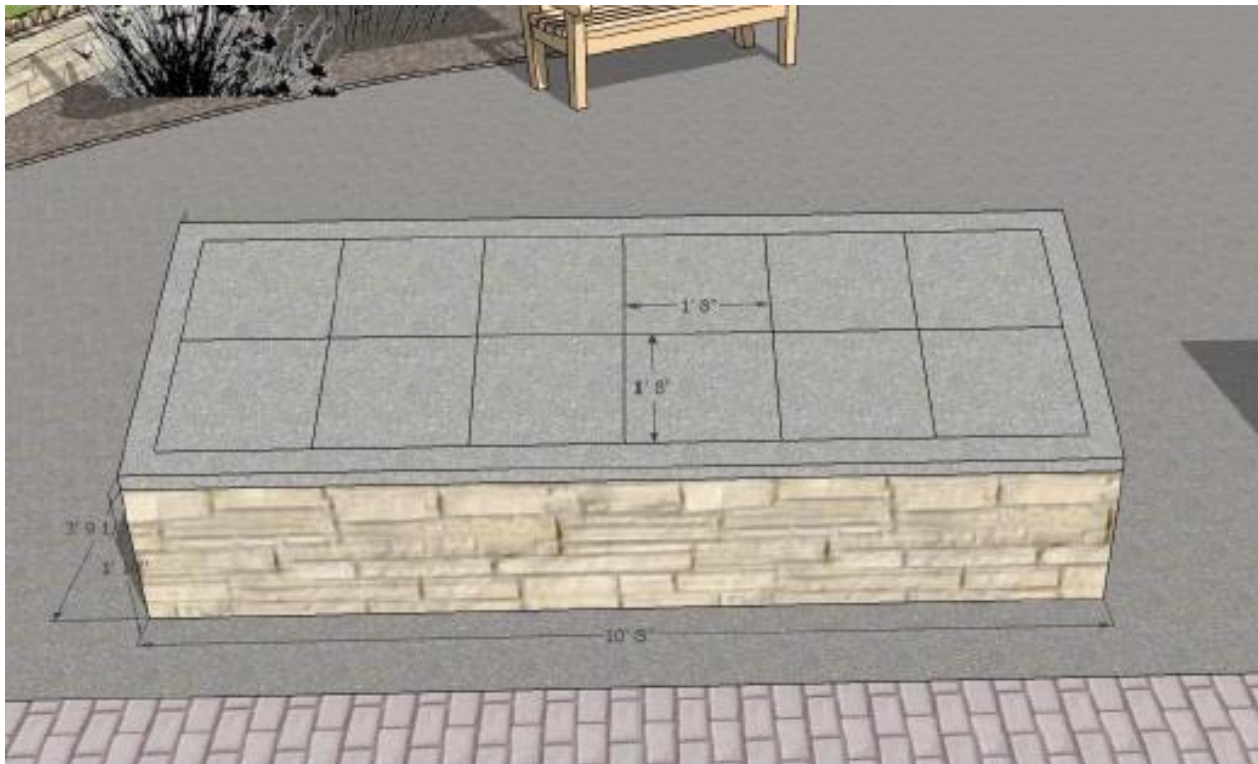

Limestone White Rock Walls

Limestone white rock wall will consist of cinder block foundation that will be filled with concrete to make a solid foundation. The Veterans wall will be 36 inches tall on the lowest end and sloped to 46 inches tall on the back side. The limestone rock will be placed around the cinder blocks and a 2 inch border of rock will be placed around the granite tiles that consist of the veteran's names.

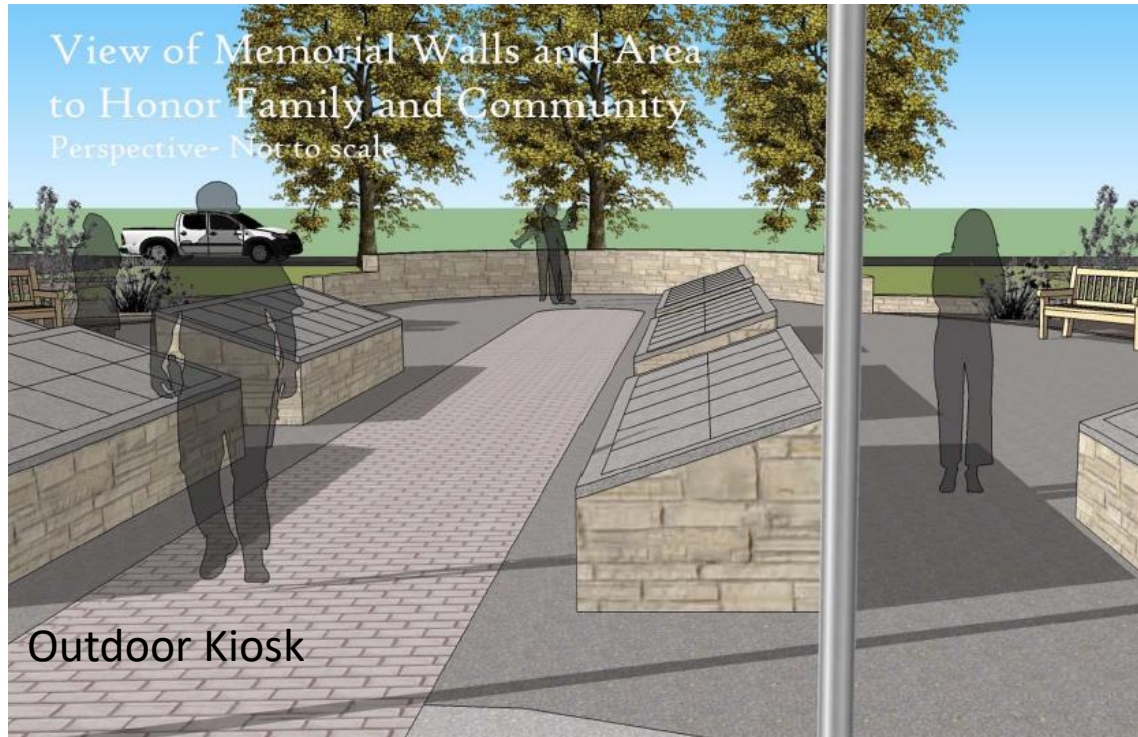


Each wall will be numbered to go along with kiosk.



- ❖ Only names will be represented
- ❖ Names will be engraved in random order with a kiosk to direct visitors
- ❖ The granite face of the walls will be tilted for ease of viewing for all visitors
- ❖ Space has been left open for future additions of these walls

- ❖ A stone veneer is planned for the lower portion of each wall
- ❖ Spacing has been designed to allow for wheelchair accessibility
- ❖ However, the spacing between each wall has been kept purposefully narrow to encourage visitors to interact with the entire space, not just one wall



Rock Wall Construction Price

12 granite tiles approximately 380-400 names

1 inch lettering government font (6 tiles on top and 6 tiles on the bottom)

Wall 13 ft wide X 4 ft front to back X 5 ft tall sloping down to 3 ft tall

Materials and labor - \$3,900.00 each wall

12 granite tiles with engraving - \$4,680.00

TOTAL (cost of 10 granite tiles and rock wall construction)= **\$8,580.00**

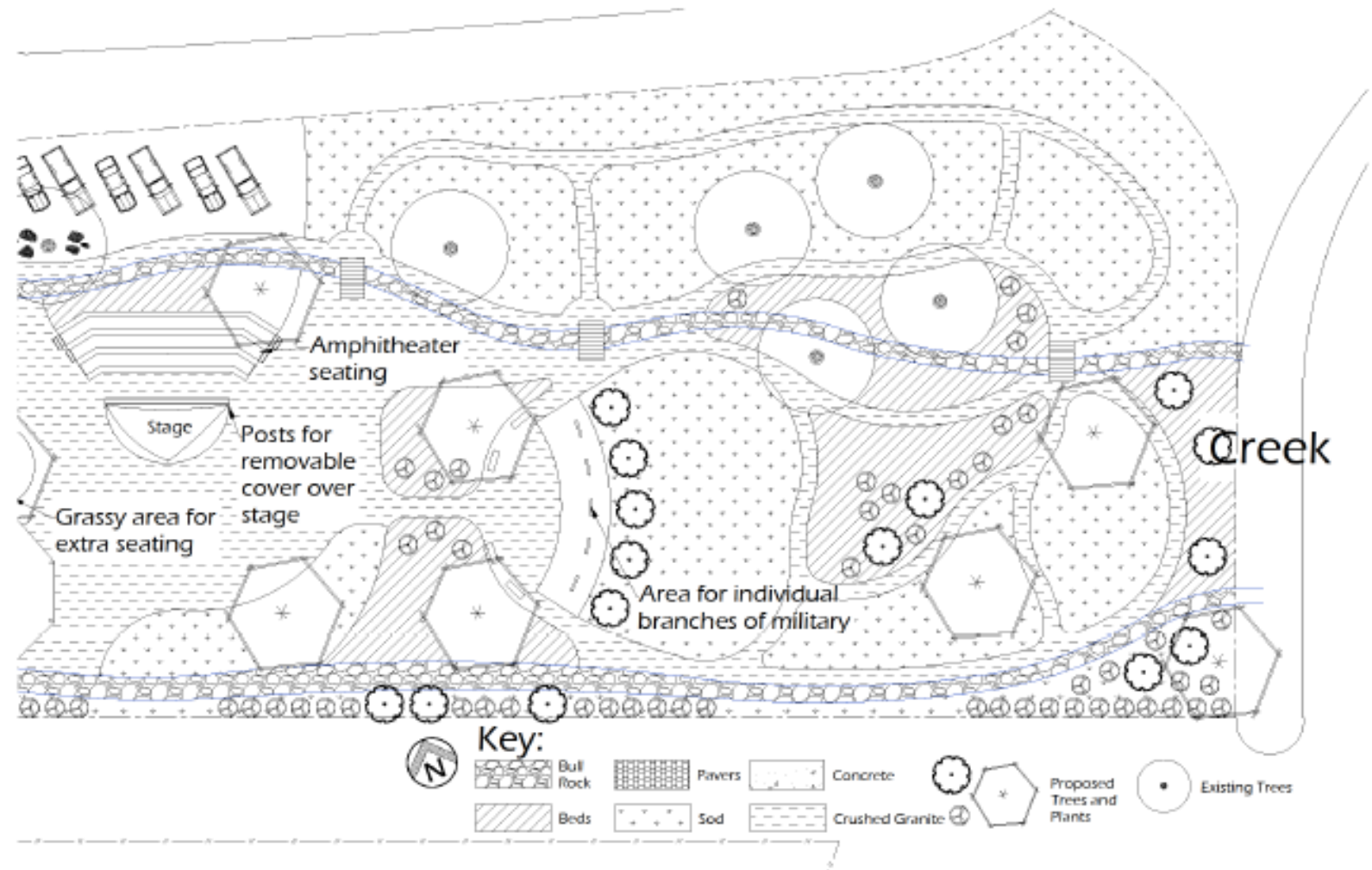

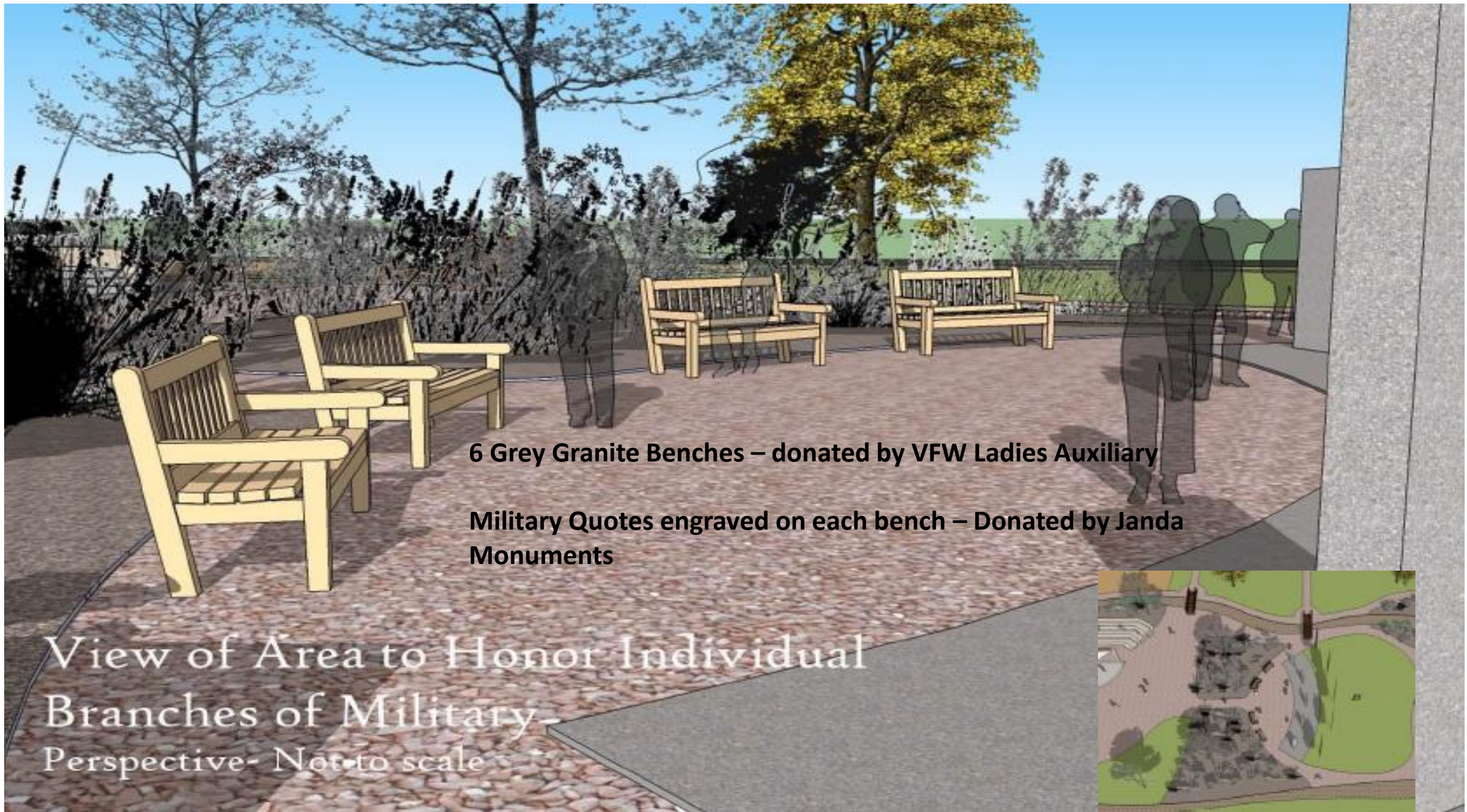

Recognizing Individual Branches of Military and Walking Paths

- Static Military Air Craft
- Narrow path between bed areas funnels visitors into secondary memorial area
- Individual branches of military are honored with a representation of their seal on a 7' tall x 8" thick x 3' wide granite monument
- Small ornamental trees planted behind monuments to frame the view
- Walking paths open behind monument area with open grassy spaces and native beds
- Drainage swales drain into existing concrete creek at end of site

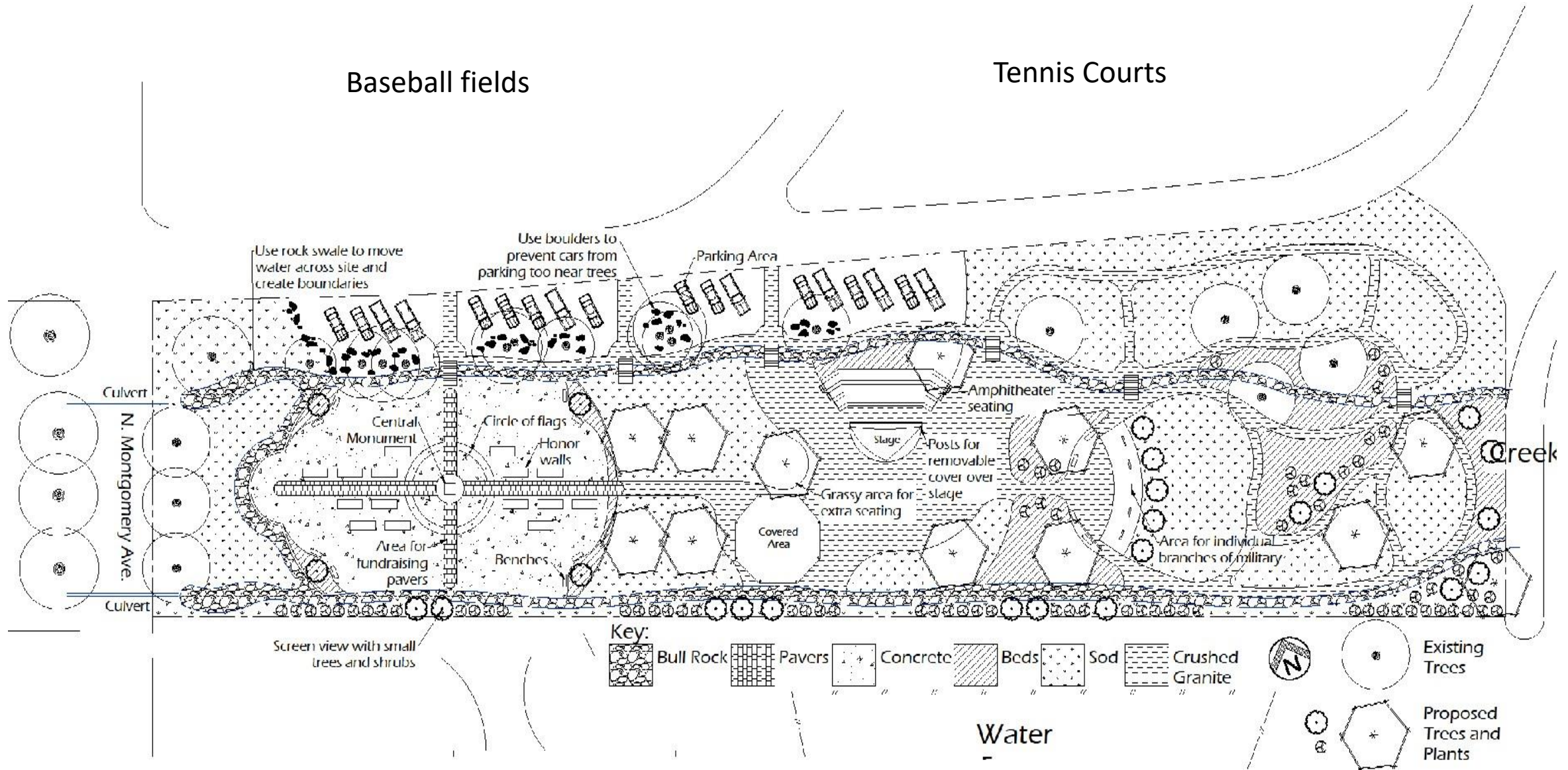
