- Only **highlight the best bits in the Education section** (this will allow you to keep it shorter too). No need to include all of your university module grades (I've only added my three best ones).
- Save the final document as a pdf and as 'Name Surname Company' (e.g. "Imtiyaz Khan Freshfeilds.pdf")
