

# WHAT TO PUT IN RECYCLING BIN



## Paper / Cardboard



- Sheets of paper and envelopes
- Paper bags (***not dirty***)
- Newspapers, advertising circulars, magazines
- Cardboard boxes and wrapping paper
- Telephone directories and books
- Flat and corrugated cardboard sheets
- Shredded documents (***has to be in a closed bag with nothing else***)

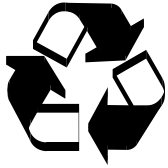
## Containers: Plastic / glass / metal

- Plastic bags (clean, not greasy):  
Grocery bags, milk bag wrappers, etc.
- All plastic containers and covers with the following symbols on them:  
***(Please rinse the inside of containers)***



- Composite material containers (milk and juice cartons, etc.)
- All glass bottles and containers with or without labels.
- **UNSOILED**, tin cans, aluminium plates and tinfoil, covers and corks.

## **Paper / cardboard**

Soiled or greasy paper, dirty cardboard, dirty pizza boxes, waxed paper, metallic wrapping paper, padded envelopes, composite objects like folders, briefcases, satchels, etc.

## **Plastics**

Food bags (Waxed or greasy), plastic cling wrap (meat, cheese or paté wrappers, etc.)

Tarps, styrofoam food containers, CD/DVD, Videocassettes and cases, toothpaste tubes and pumps, rubber products, PVC products, toys, plastic tools, etc.

## **Glass**

Drinking glasses, flat glass, (glass panes, mirrors, etc.)

Light bulbs and fluorescent tubes, pyrex, porcelain, ceramic and dishes (whole or broken)

## **Metal**

Paint containers, solvents, pesticides, aerosol containers, etc.

Scrap metal, pipes, nails, screws

Casseroles, pots, muffin tins

Electronic appliances (stereo, CD/DVD machines etc.)

Toys, tools
