Volunteers: As you may be aware, we are operating in 9 villages where all our children come from. We have several departments that promote the livelihoods of the community. We identified some areas that promote the wellbeing of the community and we have 30 official volunteers. This committee meet once a month and each comes from each group which comprises of 15-20 members and each group meet weekly by the support of the staff. All what we do is done through these volunteers and we always train them to take lead in their development and they are our upper hand in so many things.



Finance report besides Shared Blessings:

- Materials for school construction from Rotary Club of Kasangati- \$7600
- Other materials include trainings on child rights by CRANE NETWORK, business promotions, and Agricultural skills, among others have been provided by different friends.
- Parents have contributed about \$2500 towards the school construction i.e. bricks among others.

Projects:

- 4 groups have been empowered how to grow passion fruits and banana plantations.
- 3 groups been empowered with poultry and tree planting
- 3 groups been empowered with piggy project.
- A school has started a piggy project
- A trade school has been constructed though not yet done.
- A water source was dug and very useful in the community.
- Establishment of a tailoring school
- Construction of an a school administration office

Ideas for future projects:

- More water sources in the community.
- Construction of a health centre
- Fence the school premises with barbed wire
- Make bricks for the kindergarten and if possible construct it.
- Complete the un completed classroom block
- Construction of a kitchen

Other proposed programs are as follows:-

- Sanitation education – 84% people drink un safe water, 36% have no toilets they use bush
- Nutrition – children are malnourished, women need to be taught demonstration vegetable gardens
- HIV/AIDS awareness- Due to HIV/AIDS prevalence in the community, polygamy in community, early marriages, we need to educate people about dangers through showing films, talks, music, dance and drama.
- Since we have at least completed an administration block, we want to embark on finishing the first block that wasn't done. We also need to construct a kindergarten block that suits the toddlers from age3-6 years. We are planning to mobilize community members to make bricks that will work on this.
