I can invite all negative thoughts and uncomfortable feelings to leave as soon as I identify their presence. There is no benefit in holding on to anything generated by fear. I can seek gratitude to replace my sadness. I can seek hope to replace my despair. I can put myself in a position to heal. When I let go of that which does not serve me, I serve my own best interests and allow Love to return to its rightful place as the guiding force of my life.



Convention guidelines for District LDC as presented at 2022 Winter WSC accepted. After discussion Assembly passed a motion to give Convention \$1,000 to be repaid by September.

As we know Convention location and date has been changed.

What we learned:

- possible loss of deposit from Bonaventure, \$ amount due by new venue for food and rooms is set and Area will need to pay no matter what so attendance is very important.
- Rooms is \$149 a night valet parking included.
