Classroom and Academic Grant Program

The Washington High School Alumni Foundation is focused on raising money to support staff and students for classroom and campus activities, as well as funding scholarships for graduating seniors.

This year, we began a new program -- Classroom and Academic Grants. This program is designed to assist the instructors of Washington High School in providing quality instruction and unique learning experiences for their students. The grants would pay for things that would not be covered by a district/school budget or where that budget falls short. It could be providing for a substitute so a class can go on an educational field trip, art supplies (clay, paint), or equipment in the science labs, etc.

For the academic year, 2016-17, the Alumni Foundation has funded two grants totaling \$825 that will benefit more than 75 students.

\$225 - Resource Teacher: white board markers, world atlas, post-it notes and pocket folder-portfolios.

\$600 – Core Support: 2 HP Chromebooks to assist in curriculum delivery for students with learning disabilities.
