



CUSTOMER AGREEMENT

By enrolling in classes at Dance and Aerial Addiction, I understand and agree to the following:

- Policies outlined in the studio Code of Conduct, Dress Code, and Waiver & Release documents. We will have the original signed documents here in our studio.
 However, you can ask for a copy at any time.
- I also acknowledge that my child will not be allowed to participate in classes until all said documents (Code of Conduct, Dress Code, Waiver & Release) have been signed and submitted to an Office Staff member on or before my Child's first day of class.
- Upon enrollment, all students are required to participate in our Spring Recital.
 Costume fees for the Spring Recital will be charged in February and typically range from \$80 to \$150 per class. Please note: Group classes will not be performing in the Christmas Show. Participation in the Christmas Show will be by audition only. (Tumbling & Technique classes will not be in Spring Recital)
- To ensure a safe and positive environment for all, we reserve the right to refuse service to anyone who does not follow studio policies or guidelines.
- Withdrawals from class must be submitted in writing to the front desk or via email to danceaerialaddiction@gmail.com prior to the 15th of the following month to avoid tuition costs being posted to the account. Refunds, credits, or transfers will not be issued. Withdrawals must be handled through an Office Staff member, and not in class with an instructor. If a student discontinues coming to class and has not been withdrawn in writing, the responsible party listed on file is still liable for tuition until a written withdrawal is submitted.
- Please note: Dance and Aerial Addiction follows the CCSD schedule. We will be closed on major holidays. However, we will NOT be closed on Staff Development days. We recommend that you be aware of emails or notices provided by the studio as closure dates will be provided.
