20% to Non-PA-Sired PA-Breds finishing 1st-3rd

Owner Bonus (paid by track)

40% Parx 30% Presque Isle
30% Penn National
25% of purse earnings in restricted stakes races for PA-Sired PA-Breds finishing 1st-3rd

Stallion Award

10% of purse share earned when a registered PA-Bred by a registered PA Stallion finishes 1st, 2nd or 3rd
