Update on sewer pump replacement

Our generous donors contributed \$26,500 towards buying 2 new pumps. Right now we are functioning on one rebuilt pump with faith it will hold as long as needed. The initial estimate for replacement was \$70,000 but we are still waiting on competitive bids to include 2 new pumps, 1 electrical panel and labor for install. Donations and prayers over this matter are still needed.

Students and advisors have been serving dinner to our community weekly since January with smiling faces and hearts for service. What awesome future leaders in the making. Tiny Shelter Update

Construction and engineering efforts have resumed as of the first week of March. All work was on hold due to the very saturated ground. We are hoping to have all tiny homes completed by June. Many of you have reached out to offer help with preparing for the opening. Unfortunately, we cannot accept physical help with the construction due to contracts. When its time to open, we will need help with setting shelters up for clients.

We would like to clarify how occupancy will be considered for tiny shelters. Tiny shelters are intended for unhoused and unsheltered individuals and couples. Service animals will also be allowed. People already housed or in shelter will not qualify.

Please keep an eye out for our "open house" event coming soon inviting the public to see the tiny shelters up close as well as the Wenatchee Rescue Mission.
