

## 53<sup>rd</sup> Annual Creative Writing Contest Rules and Information

Sponsored by the Friends of the Littleton Library and Museum\*

The purpose of this contest is to promote and recognize students to write creatively. *This* should not be a classroom assignment. Authors are to use their own initiative to submit entries.

#### **CATEGORIES**

- Poetry (any length, all forms)
- Short Story (2,500 words max; such as: fiction, non-fiction, memoir, science fiction, fantasy)
- Other (such as: anime, script, essay, speech)

#### JUDGING

Entries will be judged anonymously based on originality, quality of expression and skill in handling specific forms of writing. Specific rubrics will be provided on the Friends' website. Judges decisions will be final. Winners will be notified by the judges by the week of April 13.

#### AWARDS CEREMONY

Winning authors will be presented awards on Sunday, April 26, 2020 at 2:00pm at Bemis Public Library.

#### **RULES**

- **Carefully read and follow rules**.
- One manuscript per category (one poem, short story and/or other) may be submitted (three total).
- Each manuscript must have a separate Entry Form.
- Incomplete Entry Forms will be subject to disqualification.
- **D** The author's name should ONLY appear on the Entry Form.
- Entries must be the work of an individual, not joint ownership.
- □ Manuscripts may be typed or printed legibly on only one side of an 8 ½" x 11" sheet.
- **□** Label each page of the manuscript with the TITLE of the work and the PAGE NUMBER.
- □ First grade authors may dictate their entries.
- Do not use a folder or a cover.
- □ All students in **1**<sup>st</sup> **through 12**<sup>th</sup> grades are eligible.
- Authors must reside within or attend a school located within the Littleton Public Schools boundaries.
- Manuscripts will not be returned.
- All winning entries will be bound in a book and copies will be available for purchase. Past year books may be referenced in the children's room at the library.
- Entries are due by 5:00pm, Saturday, March 28, 2020.
