orty six years ago a small group of community leaders met and decided that they needed an event to showcase the great fall fishing Southport-Oak Island area has to offer. The prizes and expenses for the first tournament were guaranteed by those community leaders signing a promissory note at a local financial institution - thus the U.S. Open King Mackerel Tournament was born. The U.S. Open King Mackerel Tournament now attracts over 400 boats of all sizes annually and is held in high esteem by the community and anglers.

2024 Tournament Dates

The U.S. Open King Mackerel Tournament will be held October 3rd - 5th in 2024. Headquarters is planned to be at Dutchman Creek Park. 
US Open King Mackerel Tournament Facts

- The U.S. Open King Mackerel Tournament is the second oldest competitive king mackerel fishing tournament in North Carolina. It began in 1979 and has been held annually on the first weekend in October since that time. It is the largest king mackerel tournament on the East Coast. U.S. Open King Mackerel Tournament celebrated its 45th Anniversary in 2023.
- Total purse for the 2021 tournament was over \$423,600 in CASH and \$412,086 in 2023.
- All Prizes in the U.S. Open King Mackerel Tournament are guaranteed. We do not base payout on number of boats that participate. However, in 2023 the tournament Board of

Directors voluntarily increased the payout over \$19,000 by paying an additional 55 places largest category

- 561 boats entered the 2021 US Open breaking the 551 boats tournament held in 2001.
- In 2009, the U.S. Open captured the title of largest king mackerel tournament on the East Coast and possibly the nation with 453 boats.
- In 2021, participants came from 9 different states - including North Carolina, Florida, Georgia, Maryland, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, and West Virginia. There were 151 different cities represented from North Carolina.
- Almost 300 boats entered the 1999 U.S. Open after it was postponed from its October date to late November due to Hurricane Floyd. 305 boats entered the 2010 U.S. Open after it was postponed due to a unique rain event.
- Southport-Oak Island Area Chamber of Commerce officials estimates the economic impact of the U.S. Open King Mackerel Tournament is well over \$2 million dollars.
- Entry fee for the U.S. Open is \$350.00 per boat. A very low fee to attract every level of competitor.
- 5,000 brochure/registration forms bearing the names of the tournament sponsors will be delivered this year in an area reaching from Ohio to Florida.
- The U.S. Open King Mackerel Tournament is governed by an eight-member board of directors comprised of volunteers from the Southport-Oak Island Area Chamber of Commerce and assisted by the Chamber's professional staff.
- The Southport-Oak Island area is a region of over 28,168 residents. Brunswick County, NC has 153,064 residents (2022 population esti-

mates), and is ranked 5th in the state for visitor spending in 2022 with \$1.1 billion.



Military Ocean Terminal Sunny Point

Sunny Point (MOTSU) is one of the largest military terminals in the world. It serves as a transfer point between rail, trucks, and ships for the import and export of weapons, ammunition, explosives and military equipment for the United States Army and is operated by the 596th Transportation Brigade.

The terminal lies between the small town of Boiling Spring Lakes, North Carolina, and the Cape Fear River a few miles upstream of Fort Johnston (North Carolina) and the small city of Southport, North Carolina.

Built in 1951 and opened in 1955, the facility is situated on an Army-owned 8,500-acre (34 km2) site on the banks of the Cape Fear River in Brunswick and New Hanover

ilitary Ocean Terminal counties of North Carolina approximately 16 miles (26 km) south of Wilmington, North Carolina. An additional 2,100 acres (8.5 km2) was set aside on Pleasure Island (location of Carolina, Kure, and Fort Fisher beaches) as a buffer zone around the facility.

Visitor Spending in Brunswick County Increases by 7.5 Percent to \$1.17 Billion

omestic and international nomics. visitors in Brunswick County spent \$1.17 billion in 2023, an increase of 7.5 percent from 2022. Brunswick County ranked No. 6 among the North Carolina's 100 counties in visitor spending in 2023. This data comes from an annual study commissioned by Visit North Carolina, a unit of the Economic Development Partnership of North Carolina.

"We're pleased to announce the continued growth in the economic impact of visitor spending in Brunswick County. The data released by Visit North Carolina highlights just how important tourism is to the county's economy," stated Whitney Sauls, chairperson of the Brunswick County Tourism Development Authority. "The money visitors spend in our county helps to support small businesses, creates jobs, and generates funds for beach renourishment."

Brunswick County tourism impact highlights for 2023:

- The travel and tourism industry directly employed more than 5,595 people in Brunswick County, up 6 percent from 2022.
- Total payroll directly generated by the tourism industry in Brunswick County was \$230.5 million, up 8 percent from 2022.
- State tax revenue generated in Brunswick County totaled \$35.5 through state sales and excise taxes, and taxes on personal and corporate income. About \$48.4 in local taxes were generated from occupancy, sales and property tax revenue from travel-generated and travel-supported businesses.
- Each Brunswick County resident saved \$524.97 in state and local taxes as a result of visitor spending in the county.

These statistics come from the "Economic Impact of Travel on North Carolina Counties 2023," which can be accessed at partners. visitnc.com/economic-impact-studies. The study was prepared for Visit North Carolina by Tourism Eco-

Statewide, visitor spending in 2023 rose 6.9 percent to reach a record \$35.6 billion. Direct tourism employment increased 4.8 percent to 227,224.


"The new study underscores the importance of tourism to every county in North Carolina," said Wit Tuttell, executive director of Visit NC. "There's a lot of competition for travelers' time and money, and we owe our success to everything from the state's scenic beauty and outdoor adventure to our mix of tradition and innovation and our welcoming spirit. Those qualities might be hard to measure, but we can follow the trail to a measurable impact on our workforce, our businesses and our tax base. We look forward to continued success."

NC tourism facts:

- Total spending by domestic and international visitors in North Carolina reached \$35.6 billion in 2023. That sum represents a 6.9 percent increase over 2022 expenditures.
- Visitors to North Carolina generated nearly \$4.5 billion in federal, state and local taxes in 2023. The total represents a 5.8 percent increase from 2022.
- State tax receipts from visitor spending rose 5.6 percent to \$1.3 billion in 2023.
- Local tax receipts grew 5.4 percent to \$1.2 billion.
- Direct tourism employment in North Carolina increased 4.8 percent to 227,224.
- Direct tourism payroll increased 6.6 percent to nearly \$9.3 billion.
- Each North Carolina household saved \$518 on average in state and local taxes as a direct result of visitor spending in the state. Savings per capita averaged \$239.


