The Granddaddy of King Mackerel Tournaments- September 30 & October 1

he 44th Annual U.S. Open King Mackerel Tournament is right around the corner. This year's tournament will be September 29th - October 1st at Brunswick County's Dutchman Creek Park. The U.S. Open is one of the largest king mackerel tournaments on the East Coast of the United States and part of the SKA (Southern Kingfish Association) Tournament Trail. In 2021, the tournament attracted 561 boats and paid out over \$423,600. The Tournament has an all cash guaranteed prize structure that is not based on participation numbers. It pays 55 places in its primary prize category including \$25,000 for the largest king mackerel. There are also forty sponsors such who add supplementary cash prizes to the event.

Three notable prizes include the Daily Aggregate Weight Prizes, Senior Angler and Junior Angler Awards. The Daily Aggregate Weight Prizes are sponsored by Sea/Tow and Dosher Memorial Hospital and Junior Angler Awards are sponsored by Oak Island Accommodations, Coastal Pediatric Dentistry and Novant Health. Each day a \$1,000 Aggregate Prize will be given to the boat that catches the most poundage from combining the weights from two or three fish. The Junior Angler Aggregate prizes are daily and total \$1.000 while the overall senior aggregate is a two-day total with a \$500 award.





Home Prices are Hot in Brunswick County's Market

Homes Spending Less than a Month on the Market

une brought yet another increase in home prices to Brunswick County, with more than half of homes sold selling at or above list price. Total sales volume was down slightly due to tight inventory and fewer homes being sold.

"Our market's performance continues to impress me despite the tight inventory, and at this rate I don't see prices dipping anytime soon," said Cynthia Walsh, BCAR CEO. "With the majority of homes selling for list price or more, strong demand is apparent, and I have no doubt that we'll hit the \$2 billion mark by the end of the year."

Brunswick County saw \$248,140,000 in total sales volume in June 2022, a 3.8% decrease from last June's \$257,860,000. The average sales price increased 23.2%, from \$387,170 to \$477,185. New listings increased 3.4%, from 678 to 701. The number of units sold in June dropped 21.9% compared to last year, from 666 to 520, and homes spent an average of 27 days on the market. The absorption rate, which is the amount of time it would take to sell all available inventory, is 1.7 months. Of the 520 homes sold in June, 68% sold at or above list price. Brunswick County's luxury market remained strong in June with 33 sales of \$1 million or more, with the highest transaction under \$4 million.

Year-to-date sales volume through June is \$1,292,200,000, down 0.5% from \$1,298,469,429 last year. Average sales prices for the year are 18.8% higher than 2021, increasing from \$370,896 to \$440,574. The number of units sold through June is down 18.2%, from 3,485 to 2,850, and the number of new listings is down 8.1%, from 3,772 to 3,468.

biggest reasons for those suffering from addiction not seeking IMMEDIATE treatment assistance is lack of knowledge, lack of money and lack of transportation.

How The Program Works:

- Individuals with addictions can contact the Sheriff's Office through self-referral, social referral or officer interaction.
- Once contact is made, the person requesting assistance declares they are addicted and request assistance.
- Participants will not be charged with drugs or paraphernalia found in their possession if socially or self-referred. Participants are not asked where the drugs came from during these encounters. Those encountered by law enforcement while in the criminal element are subject to arrest, however the arrest does not disqualify them from Anchor assistance.
- The individual will be put in immediate contact with an Anchor coordinator, who will respond and do an assessment.
- The coordinator will contact RHA Mobile Crisis or a like entity to start the process of finding availability for detox facilities.

- If the individual is in need of medical treatment, the coordinator will transport then to the local ER to be checked out.
- During this process the Anchor Coordinator will be working to find the individual with a treatment option, first seeking inpatient, comprehensive outpatient or intensive outpatient.
- The Anchor coordinator will be working with the volunteer group to provide transportation to and from the ER, Detox and Treatment as needed.
- The Initiative will strive to keep the cost for these individuals as low as possible, paying for the transportation, Detox (if necessary) and initial entrance fees to treatment providers (if necessary).







Oak Island to Begin Providing Rescue Tubes at ALL Beach Access Locations

New \$16,500 partnership with Jack Helbig Memorial Foundation offers boost to public safety

n Friday, July 22, 2022, the Town of Oak Island received a letter from the Jack Helbig Memorial Foundation (JHMF) proposing a new partnership with the Town to increase overall beach safety and help prevent drownings.

The partnership would combine \$10,000 from JHMF and \$6,500 from the Town to establish "Water Safety Stations" at each of the 65 public Beach Access Locations in Oak Island. Over the following two weeks, the Town has worked closely with JHMF to finalize the details of this agreement and is excited to officially announce the new partnership.

The Water Safety Stations would consist of a numbered post on the beach side of all Access Locations and include:

- A Rescue Tube from the Rescue Tube Foundation.
- A new Beach Safety Information sign, displaying a QR code that links to the most current Beach Warning Flag condition and explanations, along with graphics showing instructions on how to use the Rescue Tube.

This joint effort provides an affordable and sustainable solution to help residents and visitors ensure their own personal safety. Both the Rescue Tubes and Beach Safety Signs have been ordered and are anticipated to arrive by the end of August, with installation by the Labor Day holiday.

The new Beach Safety Information signs feature familiar design elements found in the recently installed Emergency Vehicle Access signage. These will replace the previously installed Beach Warning Flag signs, which were also provided by JHMF. Oak Is



land Water Rescue will oversee their redistribution to businesses and organizations within the community, to further assist in awareness efforts.

The Jack Helbig Memorial Foundation (JHMF) is a 501c3 non-profit based in Brunswick County since 2012. Their mission is to prevent drowning through education and



Consumer Services Corporation (RCSC). Terms can be as long as 60 months, and payments are included with your monthly electric bill.

Togetherwesave.com has a list of energy efficiency ideas for you to consider. Eligible projects include new heat pumps with a minimum 15 SEER rating, new electric or sola water heaters, ENERGY STAR replacement windows and doors, insulation of all types, and duct repair or replacement.

If you own your home served by the cooperative, receive a monthly



electric bill and have two years of service with a good payment history, the loan process is simple.

- 1) Choose a contractor (must be licensed for heat pump installation)
 - 2) Obtain cost estimates
- 3) Complete an application at any BEMC office or at bemc.org/weatherization-loans


