For over 220 years Southport has celebrated our nation's independence in full fare. The history of North Carolina's Fourth of July Festival celebration was first recorded in a newspaper in 1795. Now the event has grown to attract over 60,000 visitors each year. Through the years it's the efforts of civic groups and citizens that has allowed the festival to evolve to encompass a wide variety of American celebration traditions.

Last year's official NC 4th of July Festival events were completely virtual due to the need for instituting public health mitigation measures with guidelines for gathering, public events and social distancing set by the CDC, the state of North Carolina and local government. Virtual events may still be viewed online at the festival's website and provide a great deal of depth and history.



Business in the Front. Party in the Back. The Mullet Opens on the Southport Waterfront





Dosher Drug Drop Reports Record Turnout

his semi-annual medication collection event, which was on pause last year due to COV-ID-19, saw participation from over 700 households.

Local households discarded more than 30,000 expired or unwanted narcotic pills and nearly 3,700 millilitres of narcotic liquids at Dosher Memorial Hospital's semi-annual Operation Medicine Cabinet, held Thursday, April 22nd. Vehicles and pedestrians drove or walked by the front entrance to drop off the medications from 730 households, which accounts for the largest community turn out for this semi-annual event, which was temporarily paused in 2020 due to COVID-19.

"We've had people drop off two bottles of medication and we've seen people bring us several bags," said Lynda Stanley, President of Dosher Memorial Hospital and Foundation. "We are glad to take anything they want to bring us, since that means they are not flushing it into our water supplies or allowing it to get into the wrong hands."

speaks to our community's desire to dispose of their medications safely and responsibly," said Dr. Brad Hilaman, Dosher CEO and CMO. "Proper drug disposal saves lives and protects the environment, and we want to thank local residents for being conscientious about how they discard their medications."

In addition to Dosher employees, Brunswick County Sheriff's Department and Southport Police were on-site to assist and to provide law enforcement. Medications collected were sorted and then transported from the hospital grounds for safe incineration.

This was the 22nd semi-annual drug drop held by Dosher Memorial Hospital and has become a much anticipated community event. After a brief hiatus in 2020 due to COV-ID-19 safety, the hospital plans to reinstate Operation Medicine Cabinet on it's traditional April/October schedule, with the next collection of unwanted prescription medications taking place on Thursday October 7, "The large turnout for this event 2021, at the hospital front entrance.

Why Beating the Peak Matters

bers to voluntarily limit energy usage during Beat the Peak alerts, which are times of peak demand. These are usually three-hour windows when we are expecting a high or low temperature for the month. The rate we pay for wholesale power is partly based on the highest hour of peak demand, and we have the power to collectively reduce what we pay by lowering the peak.


Keeping peak demand as low as possible also helps us avoid needing more capacity. If we can work together to reduce peak demand, we can avoid, or delay, expensive upgrades to our infrastructure and the building of new power generating plants.

Members who participate during Beat the Peak alerts do things like adjusting their thermostats a few degrees, and avoiding doing dishes, laundry, showering and cooking. But even turning off just one light bulb can help. If you're not receiving Beat the Peak alerts and would like to, please call (800) 842-5871. 

he Sheriff's Office continues munities. to receive reports from members of our community who have received calls, emails, or messages from various places that appear to be scam. Unfortunately, there are so many scams making their way around our area and beyond, it can be hard to keep up with what latest scams are out there and even old scams that rear their ugly heads.

Because so many scams originate in other areas of the world, they can be very difficult to investigate from a local level. We encourage people to certainly let the Sheriff's Office know when they believe they have been victimized by a scam so that we can put a warning out to the community. But, the best way to report scam is through the Federal Trade Commission. Their website has all the information needed based on what platform the scam occurred, ie. by phone, email, social media, etc. When scam is reported, the FTC can use the information to build cases against scammers, spot trends, educate the public, and share data about what is happening in our com-

We have established a new resource on our website where the community can go read

about the latest scams out there. We thought it would be helpful to have descriptions of these scams all in one place. We will do our best to keep the information updated as we hear about new scams, or different spins on old ones. The website includes links to the FTC website that describes what to do when you are scammed and how to report it.

everyone to share this information with family, friends and neighbors, especially the elderly.





Number of Homes Sold in Brunswick County Skyrockets in May

runswick County's residential real estate market once again saw record numbers in May, with the number of units sold year-to-date 50% ahead of last year's record pace. Additionally, the number of units sold in May is higher than any May in the past 20 years. The inventory of available homes is at a record low level, homes are selling faster than the market has seen in the past 20 years and sellers are receiving more than their listed price.

"Our market's performance continues to amaze me, and we are seeing numbers we haven't seen in a long time, if ever," said BCAR CEO Cynthia Walsh. "The number of pending listings is high, and homes are selling quickly without price drops. Brunswick County remains red-hot, and I see no indications of a slowdown in the near future."

Brunswick County saw \$246,960,000 in total sales in May 2021, a 133.2% increase over last May's \$105,900,000. The number of units sold jumped 77.7%, from 349 to 620. The average sale price increased 31.3%, from \$303,439 to \$398,323. The number of active listings is at an all-time low of 655, while the number of active listings in the entire N.C. Regional MLS is lower than Brunswick County's active

Brunswick County's Northwest Water Treatment Plant Reverse Osmosis Project Receives National Recognition in American Water Works **Association** Publication

runswick County's ongoing work to remove per and poly-flouroalkyl (PFAS) substances from our drinking water was recently featured as the cover story in the American Water Works Association's Journal AWWA.

The article published in May focuses on Brunswick County's efforts with consultants at CDM Smith to research and test several advanced water treatment technologies such as low-pressure reverse osmosis, granular activated carbon and ion exchange following the discovery of PFAS compounds like GenX in the Cape Fear River in 2017.

Following a desktop analysis, low-pressure reverse osmosis was identified as the most effective op- swickcountync. tion to remove a wide variety of PFAS compounds and other possible contaminants of concern. It is also considered the most resilient in the event of contaminant spikes from upstream dischargers.

A pilot study using low-pressure reverse osmosis treatment at the plant further confirmed the treatment system's effectiveness at removing these compounds from water, most of which are currently unregulated at the federal and state level. The Brunswick County Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the selection of low-pressure reverse osmosis treatment in 2018.

Lights Out! It's Turtle Season!

Why all the hubbub about Sea Turtles?

Here is some information on why our volunteers work so tirelessly every year during Turtle season.

Sea turtles have played vital roles in maintaining the health of the world's oceans for more than 100 million years. These roles range from maintaining productive coral reef ecosystems to transporting essential nutrients from the oceans to beaches and coastal dunes.

Major changes have occurred in the oceans because sea turtles have been virtually eliminated from many areas of the globe. Commercial fishing, loss of nesting habitat and climate change are among the human-caused threats pushing sea turtles towards extinction. As sea turtle populations decline, so does their ability to fulfill vital functions in ocean ecosystems.

Our oceans are unhealthy and under significant threat from overfishing, pollution and climate change. It is time for us to protect sea turtles and rebuild their populations to healthy levels as a vital step in ensuring healthy and resilient oceans for the future.


Each year our volunteers monitor the beach-

es and once a new nest is discovered, it is roped off and a sign with the nest number is installed. Approximately 50 days after a nest is laid, Nest Parents begin a nightly vigil, monitoring the nest for the emergence of hatchlings, and protecting them from any predators, bright lights, or other hazards which could hinder a safe journey to the ocean. Nest Parents set up a runway from the nest using



green landscape edging or wooden boards which is maintained until the nest hatches and is excavated.

You can do your part to protect our Sea Turtles by not disturbing the nests, keeping bright lights away from the nests, and if you see a disturbed nest or see a sick or injured turtle North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission 24 hour The Oak Island



- Plan for your pets and kids
- Be prepared to leave immediately

If you are in an area ordered to evacuate, your destination could be a friend or family member's house - it doesn't have to be hundreds of miles away. If you live in a well-built home outside the evacuation zone, your safest option might be to stay home. Know your options and have a few of them.

Assemble hurricane emergency kit

It's important to have enough supplies before disaster strikes, but also enough supplies for the aftermath. Electricity and water could be out for at least three days, so prepare accordingly.

- Food and water
- A full tank of gas
- Cash
- Medicine and prescriptions
- Batteries, phone chargers, radio
- Don't forget to plan for pets and kids as well.

Get an insurance checkup

Before disaster strikes, check in with your insurance agent to make sure your policies are up to date.

- Make sure you have enough homeowners insurance for repairs or replacement if needed
- Check coverage for your car and boat, too
- Keep documents with you
- Remember, standard homeowners insurance doesn't cover flooding. It's a separate policy.

Strengthen your home

If you're riding out the storm in your house, here's how you can make sure it's in good shape if a storm passes through:

- Cover windows Have proper plywood or metal panels to board up the windows
- Trim trees
- Secure all doors
- Secure loose outdoor items, patio furniture
- Move your car to a safe location

Complete a Written Plan

Write down your hurricane preparedness plan now, before it's too late:

- Have a contact list (family, friends, doctors, utilities, vet, etc.)
- Have at least one contact outside the storm impact area
- Keep your important documents together
- Know your evacuation zone
- Determine where you'll go if evacuated
- Have your supplies ready
