Brunswick County Real Estate Market Sets Sales Record in 2020, Exceeding \$2 Billion

runswick County's residen- of just over two months. tial real estate market set a new record in 2020 with \$2,157,449,018 in total sales volume, up 51.3% compared to 2019. Monthly numbers also hit record highs in December, with increases in homes sold and total sales volume.

"2020 was full of unknowns and uncertainty, but Brunswick County's real estate market did more than merely stay consistent - it smashed all expectations," said BCAR CEO Cynthia Walsh. "Total sales for the year topped \$2 billion for the first time ever, and we saw record sales in December compared to last year.

In addition to the increase in sales volume, Brunswick County saw a 6.5% increase in new listings in 2020, going from 6,603 to 7,032. The number of units sold increased by 28.8% from 4,916 to 6,331, and the average sale price increased 17.5%, rising from \$290,077 to \$340,741. The largest sale of the year was over \$3,000,000, 16 sales were \$2,000,000 or greater and 248 sales were between \$800,000 to \$1,000,000.

In addition to the year-end numbers, the market also saw increased sales volume, higher prices and a tightening inventory in December. The inventory of available homes continued to drop, closing out at nearly 1,200 available homes with an absorption rate and days on market

The Sheriff's Office offers many community programs, but perhaps one of the programs for which I am most proud is our Anchor Initiative.

Too many people have lost, and continue to lose their lives because of addiction. Too many families have been ripped a part. Back in 2017, we decided it was time to take action. We began to realize we could not arrest away the problem and we were fighting the wrong war. It wasn't a war on drugs; it was a war on addic-

In researching ways law enforcement could potentially help, we learned there are typically three obstacles that those who want treatment for their addiction face; lack of knowledge of treatment facilities, money and transportation. In establishing the Anchor Initiative, our goal was to eliminate those obstacles.

Here is how the program works: Individuals with addictions who are ready for treatment can contact the Sheriff's Office through self-referral, social referral or officer interaction. Once contact is made, the person requesting assistance declares they are addicted and request assistance. Participants will not be charged with drugs or paraphernalia found in their possession if socially or self-referred. Participants are not asked where the drugs came from during these encounters. Those encountered by law enforcement while in the criminal element are subject to arrest, however the arrest does not disqualify them from Anchor assistance. The individual will be put in immediate contact with an Anchor Initiative coordinator, who will respond and do an assessment. The coordinator will contact RHA Mobile Crisis or a like entity to start the process of finding

availability for detox facilities. If the individual is in need of medical treatment, the coordinator will transport them to the local

ER to be checked out. During this process the Anchor Initiative Coordinator will be working to find the individual with a treatment option, first seeking inpatient, comprehensive outpatient or intensive outpatient services, as well as working with the volunteer group to provide transportation to and from the ER, detox and treatment as needed.

The Anchor Initiative will strive to keep the cost for these individuals as low as possible, paying for the transportation, detox (if necessary) and initial entrance fees to treatment providers (if necessary.)

The goal of the program is ultimately to save lives, but there are other benefits from a law enforcement perspective. A reduction in opiate use and related emergency calls, reduction in property crime, strengthening the law enforcement/ community bond while building partnerships and resources, and establishing a plan of action towards combating the next epidemic.

The Anchor Initiative is funded entirely by charitable donations, fund raisers and grants. Donations can be made through the Brunswick Sheriff Charitable Foundation at http://www.sheriffscharity.com/ donate/.

ince 1958, the one hundred and fifty-three feet tall Oak Island Lighthouse has offered panoramic views of the area and blue ocean water as far as the eye can see.

The new LED light at the top of Oak Island Lighthouse was installed in December 2020 after the previous light's rotating motor failed last year. The lighthouse has provided a rotating light since it was opened.

Bob Ahlers, chair of the Friends of Oak Island Lighthouse, said the U.S. Coast Guard, which maintains the light, had previously explored installing the more cost-efficient LED technology, but the sudden need to replace the failed motor expedited the process.

Ahlers said the Cape Lookout Lighthouse is among those that have been converted to LED and Cape Hatteras Lighthouse is expected to join in the future.

The LED light, which has only been operational for about a month, consists of four panels of bulbs with a reach of 24 nautical miles. The entire unit for the new Oak Island light, which is quieter and more energy conscious than its predecessors, cost about \$40,000.

"Ours is such an iconic rotation structure, and people in Oak Island and Southport recognize the movement, especially at night," said Bob Ahlers, chair of the Friends of Oak Island Lighthouse. "This is the first

and, right now, only rotating beacon in the U.S. that is provided by the U.S. Coast Guard."



While some might ask why the USCG would invest in a somewhat out-of-date means of navigation, Ahlers said there is a part to be played by lighthouses even in 2021.

As late as the 1980s, when some local mariners still didn't have radar capabilities, they needed the lighthouse. Today, it remains a sturdy sense of navigation in tough conditions like storms and thick fog.

They also offer a defining sense of place, as the Oak Island Lighthouse still has its identifying light pattern for mariners out to sea - four flashes followed by six seconds of blank.

"They are historical icons and we refer to them as a third level of navigation," Ahlers said. "You have GPS, you have radar and you have physical structures in lighthouses. This lighthouse is a fixture of this area and its light is part of that."
