HOW TO USE THE SEED LIBRARY

THIS SEED LIBRARY IS FREE PROGRAM SPONSORED BY THE MORGAN COUNTY LIBRARY & THE MORGAN COUNTY MASTER GARDENER ASSOCIATION.

WE HAVE "EARLY" SEED IN THE LIBRARY LOBBY SUCH AS TOMATO, PEPPER AND "GREENS". THIS IS SEED THAT NEEDS TO BE STARTED INDOORS OR PLANTED IN EARLY SPRING OUTSIDE. BEAN, SQUASH, MELON AND MOST FLOWER SEED SHOULD BE PLANTED AFTER THE LAST FROST IN MORGAN COUNTY.

TO BECOME A SEED LIBRARY MEMBER AND CHECK OUT SEEDS:

FILL OUT THE MEMBERSHIP FORM WITH YOUR NAME AND CONTACT INFORMATION AND GIVE IT TO THE LIBRARIAN. WE WOULD LIKE TO FOLLOW UP WITH YOUR PROGRESS AND COMMENTS ABOUT THE SEED LIBRARY.

FILL OUT THE CHECK OUT SHEET WITH YOUR NAME, THE TYPE OF SEED (EX. TOMATO) AND VARIETY (BRANDYWINE) AND THE NUMBER OF PACKETS TAKEN (EX. 1) <u>FOR EACH SEED PACKET.</u>
