

# Day 5: No One Who Truly Comes to Him Regrets It

## Devotional

Here is something worth sitting with. No one who has genuinely surrendered their life to Jesus has ever looked back and wished they had not.

They may have regrets about what came before. But the surrender itself? No one regrets that.

That is not a small thing. In a world full of decisions that disappoint, relationships that let us down, and paths that promised more than they delivered, Jesus is the one choice that holds up over time.

He is gentle. He understands where you are. He does not demand perfection before He draws close. He simply asks you to come, to learn from Him, and to trust Him with the parts of your life that feel too heavy to carry.

This five-day journey has been building toward one simple truth. Real freedom is found in Jesus Christ. Not in having fewer problems, not in feeling more confident, and not in finally getting everything right. It is found in Him.

If you have been on the fence, today is a good day to stop waiting. Flee what is pulling you down, run toward Him, and trust that He will do exactly what He promised. He will give you rest.

There is nothing like it. And you will not regret it.
