Day 1: God Came to You

Devotional

There is something remarkable about the way Jesus introduced Himself to the world. He did not stand at a distance and demand that we climb our way up to Him. He came down. Every other system of belief places the burden on the person, work harder, be better, reach higher. But Jesus walked into our mess and said, "I am the true vine." That is not a command. It is an invitation.

No matter where you are today, whether you feel close to God or miles away, He has not stopped pursuing you. The door is still open. That truth alone should change the way you start this week.
