

Day 3: Faith Is a Verb

Devotional

Faith is not a feeling you wait for. It is a step you take.

Abraham heard God's call in Genesis 12 and went, even though he did not know where He was going. He did not have a map. He did not have a guarantee. He had a word from God and the willingness to move. That was enough.

It would be years before he saw the promise fulfilled. But because he acted on what he believed, an entire nation was born. And through that nation, Jesus Christ came into the world. One obedient step, taken in imperfect faith, changed the course of human history.
