

Day 5: Fresh Wind for a Dry Season

Devotional

There are seasons in life when faith feels distant. The prayers feel hollow, the Bible feels flat, and the passion you once had seems like a memory. If you have been there, or if you are there right now, you are not alone and you are not disqualified.

Even the earliest followers of Jesus experienced this. After seasons of hardship and opposition, they gathered together and sought a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit. And He came again. The power of Pentecost was not a one-time event locked in history. It was a pattern, a promise, and an ongoing invitation.

The same Spirit who moved at Pentecost is available to you today. Whether you have never fully opened yourself to the Holy Spirit's power, or it has simply been a long time since you have, the invitation is still open. God is not holding your dry season against you. He is waiting to meet you in it.

You do not need to have it all together to come to Him. Bring your honest, unpolished heart. Bring your weariness, your doubt, and your longing for something more. He already knows what is there, and His Spirit is ready to move.

Today can be a turning point. Ask for a fresh touch. He is faithful to answer.
