

Day 2: The Giant in the Room

Devotional

Most of us are walking around with a giant in our life. Maybe it is a diagnosis, a financial crisis, a broken relationship, or a fear that just will not go away. And the longer we stare at it, the bigger it seems.

David did not stare at Goliath and wait for him to shrink. He ran toward him. Not because David was fearless, but because David knew something more important than the size of the giant. He knew the size of his God.

That same confidence is available to you today. Faith does not always make the obstacle disappear right away. The giant might still be standing there. But God will give you the peace and the boldness to look at that thing and say, "My God is bigger than you."

You were not designed to shrink back in defeat. You were designed to move forward in faith, trusting that the God who parted seas and shut the mouths of lions is walking right beside you through whatever you are facing.

The giant does not get the final word. God does.
