

Day 4: Better Together

Devotional

There is a version of faith that keeps everything personal and private. My faith, my prayers, my walk with God. And while your personal relationship with Jesus is absolutely essential, Scripture points to something even greater when believers come together.

Psalm 133 paints a beautiful picture of brothers and sisters dwelling together in unity. It is not just a nice idea. God commands His blessing in that place. There is something that happens in shared faith that simply cannot happen alone.

When Jesus looked at the paralyzed man, He did not just see one person. He saw all five of them. He saw the unity of their effort, the shared weight of their belief, and He responded to all of it together.

You were not designed to carry your faith in isolation. You were designed to be part of a community that believes together, prays together, and pushes through obstacles together. When you show up for someone else and they show up for you, God sees that. He honors it.

Do not let pride or independence keep you from the power of community. Find someone to believe with you. Be willing to believe for someone else. Together, you are stronger than you are alone.

"How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity!" - Psalm 133:1
