

Day 4: You Don't Need the Whole Map

Devotional

Abraham is one of the great heroes of faith in Scripture. But look closely at his story. God told Him to go, and he went, even though he did not know where He was going. He did not have a detailed plan. He had a direction and a God He trusted.

That is still how following Jesus works.

God is not going to show you every step before you take the first one. He gives you enough light for the next step, not a spotlight on the entire path. That can feel unsettling, especially if you are someone who likes to plan. But it is actually an invitation to trust.

Peter did not walk on water by studying the physics of it. He stepped out of the boat because Jesus said come. The moment he took his eyes off Jesus and focused on the wind and the waves, He started to sink. Our circumstances will always feel overwhelming when they become our focus. But when we keep our eyes on Jesus, even the impossible becomes possible.

You do not need to know every detail. You do not need to understand the whole plan. You simply need to take the next step. And He will be there when you do.
