Day 1: You Are Never Alone

Devotional

Life has a way of making us feel isolated. Whether it is a difficult season, a broken relationship, or a quiet moment where doubt creeps in, the feeling of being alone can be overwhelming. But here is the truth that changes everything: if you have placed your faith in Jesus, you are never truly alone.

Before Jesus ascended into heaven, He made a promise. He told His disciples that He would not leave them as orphans. He would send the Holy Spirit to be with them, and not just near them, but in them. That promise was not just for the disciples in that room. It is for you, right now, today.

Think about what that means in practical terms. In your hardest moment, when the weight of life feels unbearable and no one seems to understand, God Himself is present with you. His Spirit is not far off or distracted. He is close, attentive, and deeply personal.

This is not a comforting idea to simply feel good about. It is a foundation to stand on. When fear rises, when loneliness sets in, when you do not know what to do next, you can anchor yourself in this reality: the Creator of the universe has not left you to figure life out on your own. He is with you in the middle of it all.
