

Day 3: Go Straight to the Source

Devotional

We live in a world full of voices. Podcasts, social media, opinions, and advice come at us from every direction. And while some of those voices can be helpful, none of them can do what only Jesus can do.

When your ears need to be opened, there is only one place to go. Not to the loudest voice online. Not to secondhand spiritual content. You have to go directly to Jesus, directly to His Word, directly to His presence.

Proverbs 2:6 reminds us that wisdom comes from God. And James builds on that by telling us that if we lack wisdom, we simply need to ask. God gives generously to everyone who asks in faith. He is not holding back from you. He is not waiting for you to earn it or prove yourself. He gives freely.

But here is the key: you have to ask. Faith is not passive. It is an action. Asking God to open your ears and then actually opening your Bible, actually spending time in prayer, actually positioning yourself to hear Him, that is what faith in motion looks like.

God is not withholding from you. He is waiting for you to come to the right source. And when you do, He will speak.
