

Day 2: A Guide You Can Trust

Devotional

We live in a world flooded with information and starving for truth. Opinions are everywhere. Voices compete for your attention every single day, each one claiming to have the answers. It can be exhausting trying to figure out what is actually true and what is not.

Here is the good news. You do not have to navigate that alone. Jesus promised that the Holy Spirit would guide His followers into all truth. Not some truth. Not partial truth. All of it.

The first and most foundational way the Holy Spirit speaks is through Scripture.
