Holders of green parking passes must park on the street. Visitors with a limited number of guest parking passes may also park on the street or in visitor parking. Please Note: Vehicles on the surface street without a green street pass or a currently dated guest parking pass will be towed between the hours 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Holders of orange (garage) parking passes must park in your assigned space or also risk being towed. Thank you for your patience and understanding during this very busy summer. Your efforts make all difference and are always appreciated.

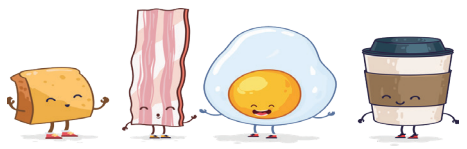


## HAPPY HOUR

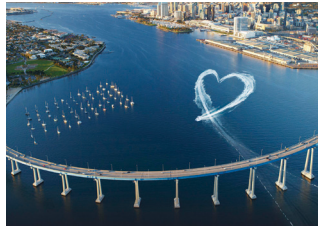
