Pools hours vary between 8am-5pm. On a good note, The Main Pool is now open Monday-Friday with the following hours:

9:15-10:15	Lap Swim Only
10:30-11:30	Lap Swim Only
12pm-1:30	Exercise Swim
1:45pm-3:15	Exercise Swim
3:30pm-5pm	Exercise Swim

As a friendly reminder, you are allowed 3 reservations per week, per unit.

Cancelations must be made 24 hours in advance.
