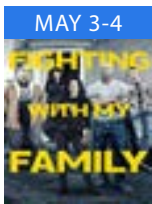
### *Family Movies*

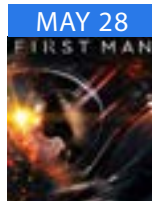
When a young woman is fed up with love, she decides to shun everything romantic. The romantic comedies she once loved are becoming a nightmare that she must relive every single day.

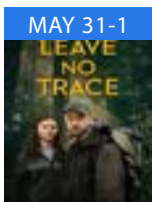
