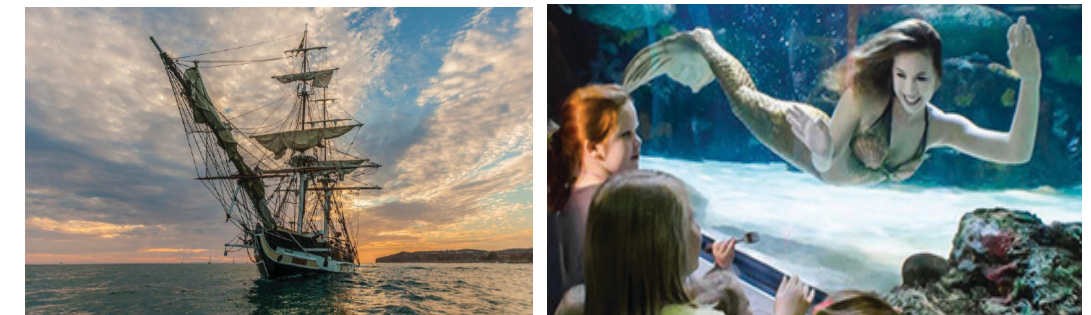

Presented by the Ocean Institute, The Tall Ships Festival is an annual family event that celebrates California's rich maritime history. Join us Sunday, September 8 as a fleet of historic tall ships sail into Dana Point Harbor. Admission includes tours of the brig Pilgrim, Spirit of Dana Point, and all visiting vessels; educational activities including squid dissections, gold panning, candle making and more; access to Sierra Nevada Beer Garden, Main Stage & Pirate Camp; and food trucks and shopping. You can enhance your festival experience with other add-on activities, including mermaid encounters and pirate school. Admission is only \$15 for adults and \$12.50 for children ages 3-14, and transportation is complimentary! Departure is at 10:30 a.m.
