Cost & Deadlines

PAID IN FULL: The **NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE** payment of **\$450.00** is due **FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2021.**

PAYMENTS: A **NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE** deposit of **\$200.00**, Code of Conduct Contract, and Liability forms for the March for Life are due **FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2021.**

Final **NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE** payment of **\$250.00** is due **FRIDAY, DECEMBER 3, 2021.**

LATE REGISTRATION AFTER NOVEMBER 12, 2021: The **NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE** payment of **\$475**, paid in full or two payments, is due by December 3, 2021.

Food & Water

Pilgrims should bring money for their meals (15 meals) during travel. About **\$150.00** is recommended for food - an average of **\$25.00** per day. Pilgrims should also be aware while in Washington DC, lunch will be quick and light and dinner will be late. **Bringing peanut-free snacks is encouraged**, some sites will not allow food.

Pilgrim should bring an empty water bottle for use for the duration of the pilgrimage.

Accommodations

Three nights will be spent in quad accommodations at the Holiday Inn Carlyle in Alexandria, Virginia.

Weather & Walking

Pilgrims should dress in layers with ear, face, and head covering to protect from COLD temperatures. Expect to walk several MILES per day. Good shoes are a must!

DC Transportation will be via Metro. College students should anticipate \$20-\$25 for Metro passes.
