



MAE LASSLEY OSAGE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

SON SE GRAY (MAE LASSLEY), Osage Allottee #634, was the donor of the monetary gift which made these scholarships possible.

Mrs. Lassley, a full blood member of the Osage Tribe, died on September 10, 1957. Although childless, she was deeply interested in young people and their welfare and dedicated her life to working in her church and helping others.

She was co-foundress of the KLASH KAH SHE (LITTLE FLOWER) CLUB, an organization for members of the Osage tribe. The club was named in honor of St. Teresa and is dedicated to the spiritual and material work of the Church.

It is a fitting tribute to a woman who dedicated her life to her God, her Church, the Osage people and suffering humanity, that after her death she would be able to help young people get an education.

The Catholic Church has enjoyed for over a century working with the Osage tribe. Long before statehood the Church was involved in the education of Osage children. This scholarship fund gives the Catholic Church an opportunity to continue its educational work for the Osage tribe.

Bishop Emeritus Edward J. Slattery, Bishop of Tulsa, has established a committee to recommend the scholarship awards. Bishop David A. Konderla continues to support the committee and the academic efforts of applicants.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR SCHOLARSHIP?

MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- **Catholic**
- **Osage on the Rolls in Pawhuska.**
- **Copy of front and back of CDIB card.**
- **Take a minimum of 12 hours for undergraduate or 6 hours for graduate studies per semester.**
- **2.5 undergraduate, 3.0 graduate GPA (3-year average).**

WHEN SHOULD YOU APPLY?

Contact us for an application. The annual deadline for the scholarship to be completed and returned to the Committee is **April 15th**.

HOW MUCH SCHOLARSHIP MONEY IS AVAILABLE?

\$10,000 per year (variable)

WHEN WILL THE SCHOLARSHIPS BE AWARDED?

The scholarships will be awarded in May for the following school year. All applicants will be notified by mail.

WHAT ARE THE AMOUNTS OF INDIVIDUAL SCHOLARSHIPS?

Minimum of \$1,000 a year.
