#### **Gathering Together**

WYD brings together young adults from all over the world as a reminder of the strength and confidence the young contribute to today's Church.

#### **Putting Trust in the Young**

WYD is a time to put trust in the world's youth and a call for unity in humanity.

# Meeting the International World on a Human Level

International events stir much hope as well as fear (for example, fundamentalism, nationalism and other new conflicts). The Church and Christians themselves have a role to play in preventing the development of these fears and aid each person in discovering hope.

#### **FAQs**

#### Days in the Diocese (DID)

Days in the Diocese are a retreat before the pilgrimage with the Holy Father. Host homes provide housing and accommodations; Mass, catechesis, praise and worship are experienced in the local parish; and cultural festivals and events allow time experience the Portuguese life.

#### World Youth Day (WYD)

WYD are the festivities are specific to the Holy Father's schedule including Opening Ceremonies, Stations of the Cross, and the Closing Mass.

Catechetical sessions are also offered in a myriad of languages to accommodate the millions in attendance.

#### **Dates**

The Vatican has not announced the dates of WYD 2023 as of September 2020. We expect the last week of July for DID and the first week of August for WYD festivities.

#### Age

Youth is defined as 18-39 years of age internationally. Thus, pilgrims must be a minimum of **18 years old** by **July 1, 2023**, and at most 39. Exceptions are made for parish youth and/or young adult coordinators and clergy.

#### **Passports**

Passports are required! You must have your passport in hand by December 2022 with a minimum of six months before expiration at the time of return.

#### **Excused Absences**

The pilgrim is responsible for speaking with their professors and/or employers in order to secure excused absences. The Diocese is NOT responsible for excused absence requests.
