

Good Neighbors Clear Their Sidewalks of Ice & Snow. Be A Good Neighbor.



A major snow event is forecasted for this weekend, beginning Saturday evening and continuing through Sunday. Montgomery County requires all sidewalks in front of and alongside properties to be cleared within hours after the snowstorm ends. To help residents prepare, we have created a list of Frequently Asked Questions and how to stay informed below for your review.

As we get ready for the snowstorm, we also encourage everyone to be a good neighbor. If you are able, please consider helping a neighbor who may need assistance with snow removal. Let's look out for one another—not just because it's required, but because it strengthens our community.

Frequently Asked Questions

Who is responsible for clearing the streets in single-family home neighborhoods?

Snow removal in single-family neighborhoods is completed by Montgomery County. Sidewalks are the responsibility of residents. For more information, click on the link below:

Who is responsible for clearing the streets in townhome neighborhoods?

Snow removal in townhome neighborhoods is completed by Waters Landing. Residents are responsible for clearing the walkway to their home.

Who is responsible for clearing the streets in condominium communities?

Condominiums have their own trash and snow removal contractors. Please contact your condominium management company. If you are unsure who your management company is, a list is available on our website:

What happens if there is a power outage caused by the snowstorm? Snowstorms can lead to a disruption in utilities. Report any power outages to [First Energy/Potomac Edison](#) (1-888-544-4877).

What is the schedule for recycling during snowstorms?

County-provided collection services are suspended when County government offices are closed. If collection is suspended due to a County closure, snow, or severe weather, recycling will be collected the next day or as soon as possible. Please leave items at the curb until collection occurs.

What is the schedule for trash collection during snowstorms?

Waters Landing's trash contractor, J & J Inc., will make every effort to complete trash collection on Monday; however, collection times may fluctuate. If roads become impassable, collection may not occur and will resume on the next scheduled trash collection day, which is Thursday.
