You should be knowledgeable of the Waters Landing Architectural Guidelines, as well as the basic materials and styles found throughout the association’s neighborhoods. These vary between single family and townhouses, as well as the alterations that Waters Landing permits within each individual neighborhood and property type. As a member of the Architectural Committee, you are responsible for overseeing the applications that are submitted by the Covenants Assistant once they are processed and participate in the evaluation and decision of approval vs disapproval. The applications must be voted on by each member, and as a member of the Committee, you are responsible for being present and available for the monthly meetings. These are currently being held digitally via Zoom. Copies of the applications will be delivered physically to your property, so that you may view and evaluate any applications prior to the date of the forth coming meeting. You will be notified of the delivery by the Covenants Assistant, and will be in contact with any staff members or other Committee members as needed.
