Dear Owners and Residents,

We have received inquiries from lot owners about the role of the Waters Landing Association in connection with zoning and development plans for property in and around the Waters Landing community. We have reviewed this issue and have consulted with the Association's legal counsel. Before the Board can take any action, it must confirm that it has legal authority to do so under the Association's governing legal documents.

We all must remember that the Association was established only for specific, limited purposes, and that the Board cannot legally take actions that are beyond the scope of its authority under the governing documents. The Association's powers and responsibilities are focused entirely on internal community functions, such as the care and upkeep of the common areas and facilities, establishing and collecting assessments, hiring and dismissing personnel and contractors, adopting and enforcing rules and regulations, purchasing insurance for the common areas, and promoting and encouraging activities in the community. The Association cannot legally act outside of the scope of the powers and responsibilities specified in the governing documents.

Plans for new developments in our area clearly are of legitimate concern to homeowners, and we encourage everyone to make their views known to County officials. However, the Association itself, as a legal entity, cannot advocate on behalf of homeowners in public proceedings on matters that may affect the owners' personal interests or property values. Owners certainly may organize independently to do this, but the Association cannot participate in any official capacity.

Though the Board may not have the authority to take direct action on proposed development activity in or around the community, we understand the importance of these issues, and we can share with homeowners any information that we may receive about such plans.

PATH SYSTEM

The asphalt path system has been completed. Over the next several weeks, Waters Landing's landscaping contractor will be going through and backfilling & seeding along the path. We thank everyone for their patience during this project and hope everyone can get out & enjoy the path soon.

TENNIS COURTS

The tennis court & multi-use areas require approximately 30-45 days to cure. Following this time, the tennis courts will have new tennis court material applied, along with lines painted for both tennis and pickle ball. We anticipate this to be completed early Fall.

PLAYGROUNDS

The playground at Rec B, along with the playgrounds in LakeCrest and Waterbury Downs North, are currently in the bidding process for replacement.

POOLS

MONTGOMERY COUNTY DEVELOPMENT NOTES

Montgomery County, through the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC), has revised the zoning for Churchill Town Sector, as that type of zoning has expired under the Germantown Master Plan.

The undeveloped parcel, located at the corner of Waters Landing Drive & Father Hurley Boulevard, is owned by the Episcopal Diocese of Washington and is not part of Waters Landing. This parcel is separate from Churchill Senior Living. Waters Landing has not received any communication regarding this parcel.

Waters Landing did not receive notice of density changes for the undeveloped property or the next phase of Churchill Senior Living.

When the zoning was originally discussed, in 2018, notice was posted on the Association webpage and again for a meeting in July 2019. The Association did not receive any additional information.

Residents are strongly encouraged to contact Montgomery County with any questions or concerns regarding development and zoning changes. <u>Montgomery Planning Board</u> is part of the <u>Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC)</u>.
