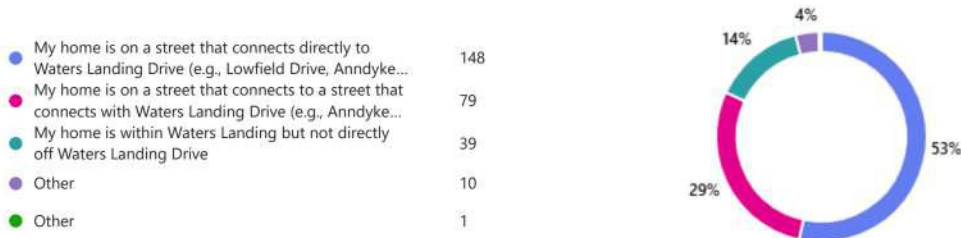

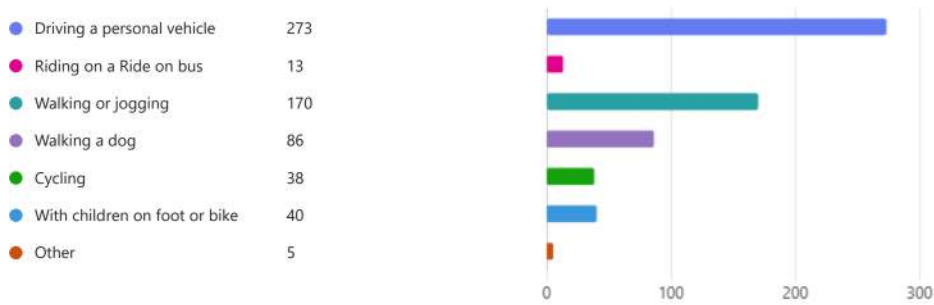
3. How many years have you lived in Waters Landing?



4. How often do you travel Waters Landing Drive?



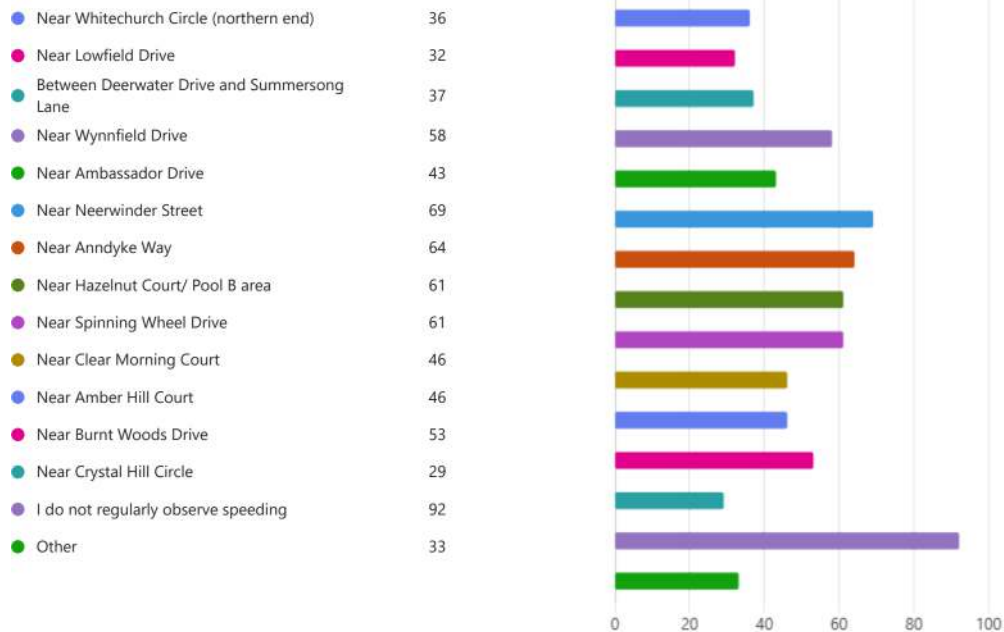
5. How do you typically use Waters Landing Drive? Select all that apply.



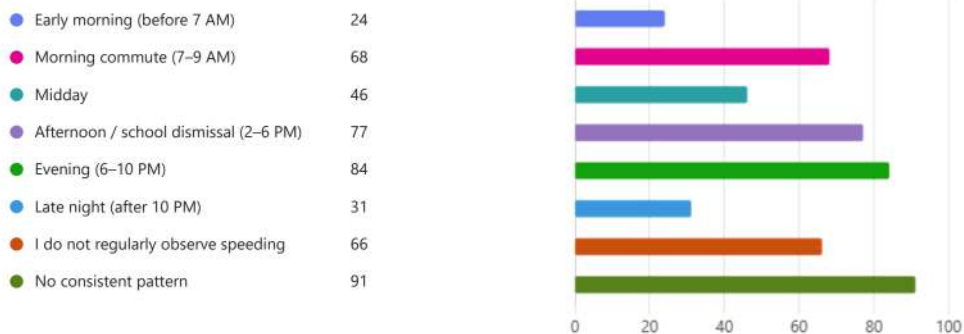
6. In your experience, how serious is speeding on Waters Landing Drive?



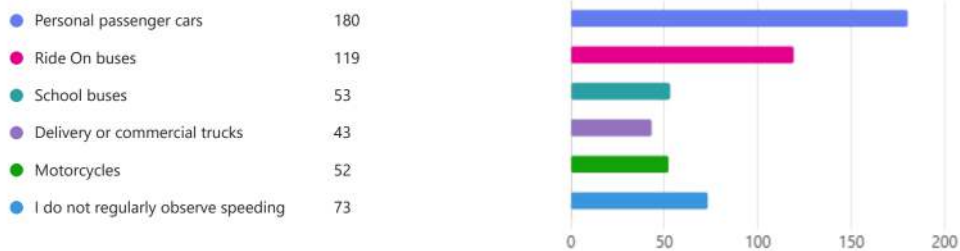
7. Where on Waters Landing Drive do you most frequently observe speeding? Select all that apply.



8. What time(s) of day do you most frequently observe speeding?

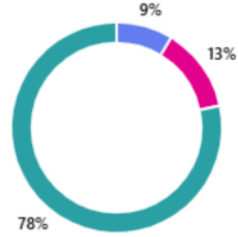


9. Which types of vehicles do you most frequently observe speeding? Select all that apply.



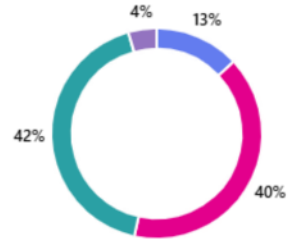

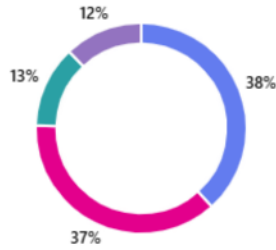
11. What is your overall position on installing speed humps on Waters Landing Drive?

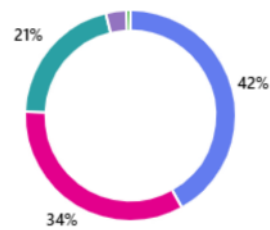
12. On a typical day, approximately how many times do you travel past one or more of the proposed speed hump locations?

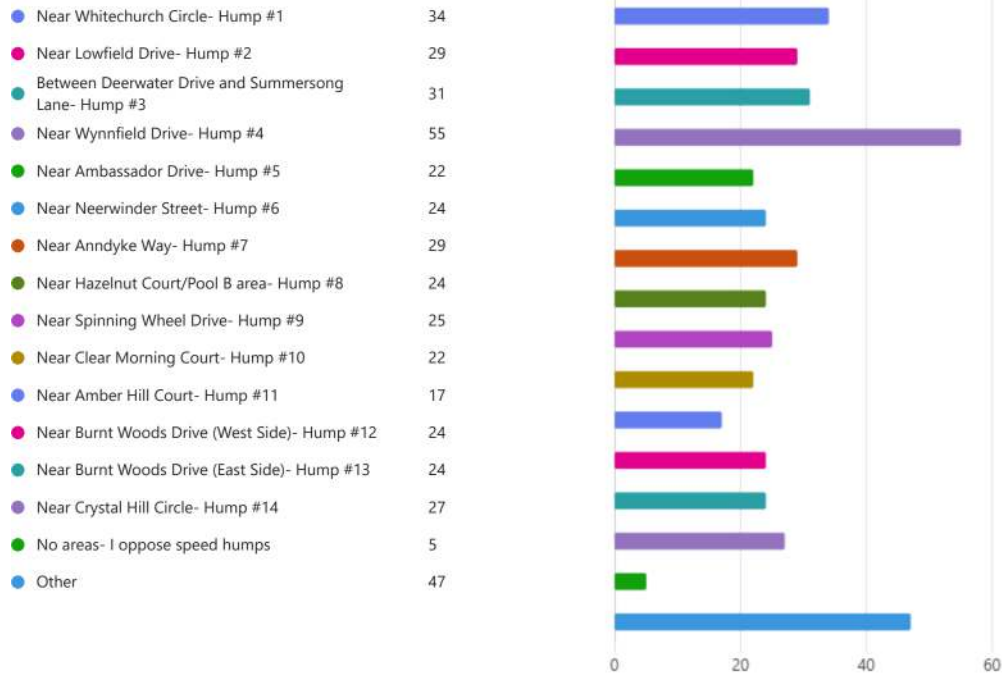


13. If speed humps are installed, how many would you consider appropriate?

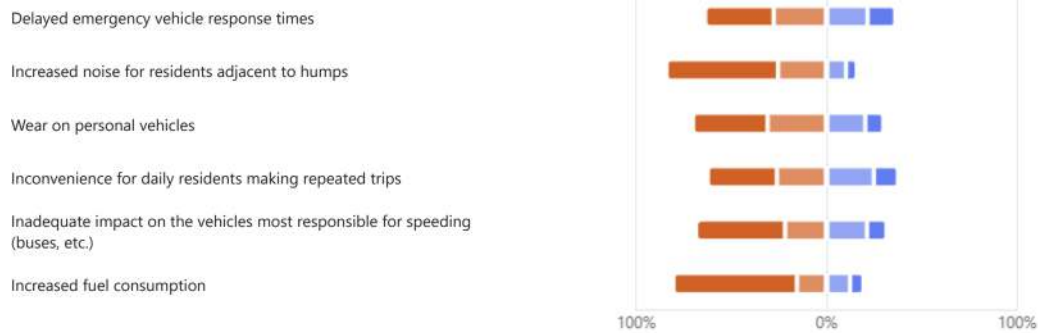

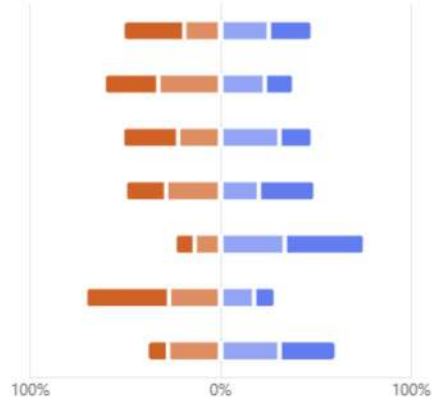

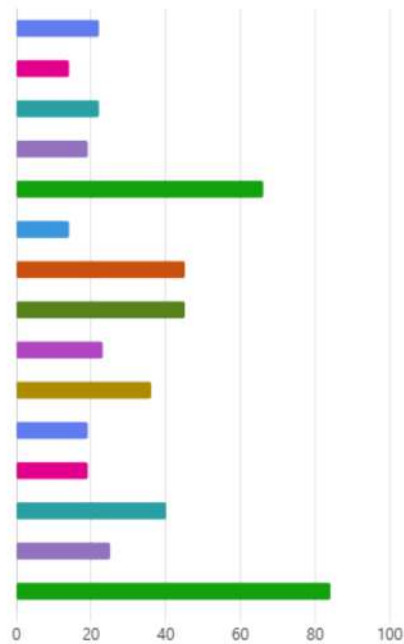
