#### **NICENE CREED**



#### THE WORDS OF OUR LORD




- As often as we eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.





#### STEWARDSHIP THOUGHT

The great Lutheran musician J.S. Bach composed a beautiful motet using this verse. It is the cry of true faith, much the same as Peter's words: "Lord, to whom shall we go?
