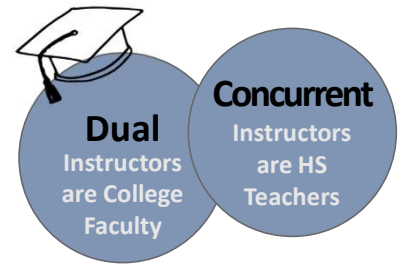

Dual and Concurrent courses allow students to earn college credit while attending high school

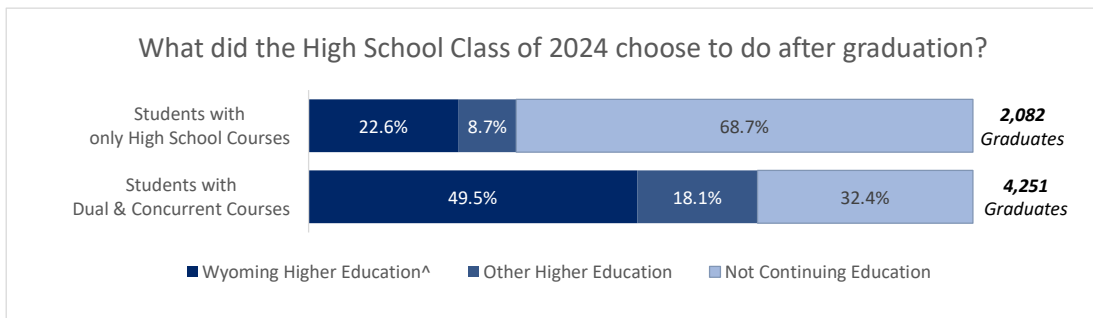
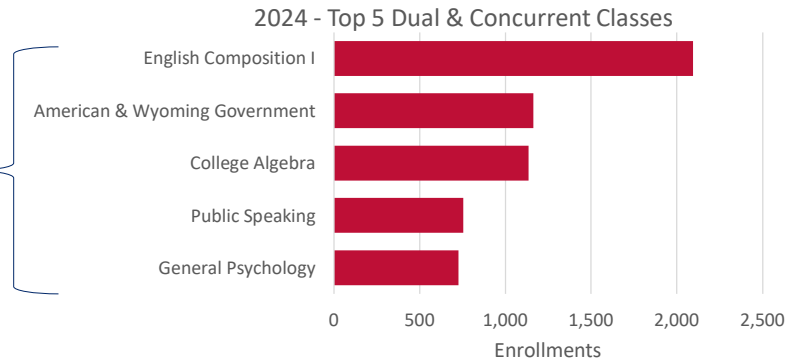


Wyoming Public High School Class of 2024
