

Be United Fingerless Gloves

Stitch Key:

FDC- foundation double crochet

ST(S)- stitch(s)

SLST- slip stitch

BLSC- back loop single crochet

CH- chain SC- single crochet

DC- double crochet

EDC- extended double crochet
or use a treble

FPDC- front post double





Cuff

18 FDC or CH 20
DC in 3rd CH for
hook 17 DC to end,
join to create ring



Row 1-3: CH2, DC in same ST, (FPDC in next, DC in next), repeat to last ST
(should be a FPDC) SLST in 1st DC

Use loose tension or hook up 1 size

Row 4-5: CH1, BLSC in every ST, SLST in the 1st SC (18 STS)

Row 6: CH1, turn, SC in same ST, EDC in next, (SC in next, EDC in the next) repeat to end, SLST into 1st SC, CH1 turn.

Row 7-9: SC in same ST, SC in every ST to end, SLST in 1st SC

Row 10: CH1, turn, SC in same ST, EDC in next, (SC in next, EDC in the next) repeat to end, SLST into 1st SC, CH1 turn.

Row 11-13: SC in same ST, SC in every ST to end, SLST in 1st SC

Row 14: CH1, turn, SC in same ST, EDC in next, (SC in next, EDC in the next) repeat to end, SLST into 1st SC, CH1 turn.

Thumb

Row 15: CH1 SC in same ST, CH8, skip 6, SC in next, SC in remaining ST, SLST in 1st SC (increases to 21 sts)

Row 16: CH1 SC in same ST, SC8 around CH8, SC in next SC, SC in remaining STS, SLST in 1st SC

Rows 17-18: CH1 SC in same ST, SC in every ST to end, SLST in 1st SC

Row 19: CH1, turn, SC in same ST, EDC in next, (SC in next, EDC in the next) repeat to end, SLST into 1st SC, CH1 turn.

Short glove to cover palm stop here

Rows 20-22: SC in same ST, SC in every ST to end, SLST in 1st SC

Rows 23-24: CH1, BLSC in every ST, SLST in the 1st SC Fasten off hide ends, or keep going for fur!

Optional Fur Edge

Row 25: SLST to join fur in ST before last SLST. CH1 SC in same ST, loosely SC in every remaining ST, SLST to 1st SC.

Fur Cuff: SLST to join fur in ST near tail, CH1 SC in same ST, jump over to the DC and SC, SC in remaining STS, SLST in 1st SC to end. Fasten off hide ends.



In cuff join fur in st with tail
(right hook)
SC where the left hook is to
stabilize the join
if you didn't use a tapestry
needle to close at the
beginning.
