## Stitches used:

Ch- chain

Slst- slip stitch

Sc- single crochet

Blsc- back loop single crochet

Dc- double crochet

Fpdc- front post double crochet

Edc (for Nubbly stitch)- extended double crochet or substitute with a treble crochet

Pattern is adjustable for yarn weight and size.



I used 4 weight, and I 5.5mm hook for the pattern with an average head circumference of 22 inches. Crown of the beanie measures 6.5 inches and top to rim was 8 inches, 4 rows of the nubbly stitch.

## Suggestions:

For Bulky 5 end crown at 3 dc between the fpdc, and 3 rows of the nubbly stitch

For DK 3 weight end crown at 6 dc between fpdc, and 5 rows of the Nubbly stitch.

### **Crown:**

ch 4, slst to join and make a ring

**R1-** ch1, 10 dc in ring, (carry along end for cinching center closed after join), slst into first dc to join (10 stitches)

**R2-** ch1, (dc, fpdc in same), repeat to end, slst into first dc to join (20 stitches)

**R3-** ch1, (dc 2, fpdc), repeat to end, join (30 stitches)

**R4-** ch1, (dc 3, fpdc) repeat to end, join (40 stitches)

**R5-** ch1, (dc 4, fpdc) repeat to end, join (50 stitches)

**R6-** ch1, (dc 5, fpdc) repeat to end, join (60 stitches) **no more increasing**

**R7-** ch1, blsc in first, blsc in every remaining stitch, slst into the bl if the first sc

**R8-** ch1, blsc in first, blsc in every remaining stitch, slst into the both loops of the 1st sc

### **Body:**

**R9-** ch1 turn, (sc in first, edc in next) repeat to end, slst to 1st sc, (60 stitches) nubbles will show on the front side of work

**R10-** ch 1 turn, sc in each stitch around (60 stitches) be careful of the last stitch. Use a stitch maker so you don't add stitches by mistake.

**R11-12** Repeat R10 but do not turn after each round

Repeat **R9-12** to desired length.

### **Rim Options:**

\*For fur- If the fur is long (like Fun Fur) ch1 turn, complete 3 rounds of sc, slst in 1st sc at the end of each round. Use a stitch marker in 1st sc so you do not lose your place.

\*If fur is short (Yarn Bee Snuggle Up) Do not turn, ch 1, complete 3 rounds of sc, slst to 1st sc at the end of each round.

\*No fur-

ch1 sc in every stitch, slst in 1st sc for 3 rounds

ch1 slst in 1st, ch1, (slst in next, ch1) repeat to end

Tie off weave in the ends.
