Ripples In The Creek

This pattern was designed for Camp Boggy Creek. The dimensions are within their parameters. If you would like to make it larger, just continue to repeat the foundation row until you reach your designed length. Enjoy!

Materials:

Aprox. 2000 yds of 4wt yarn 6.0 mm crochet hook Scissors Darning needle

Foundation row:

Ch 2 hdc into 1st ch twice, ch3 dc into 1st ch. (repeat until desired length is reached, ending with ch2 hdc into 1st ch twice)

Set-up row:

Ch2, turn, *hdc into 1st foundation loop, ch1, hdc into next foundation loop, ch1, 5dc into 3rd foundation loop ch1, repeat * across ending with hdc ch1 twice, hdc into last st.

Row 1:

Ch2 turn, *5dc into ch1 sp. (between hdcs from set-up row) ch1, sk2, fphdc around next dc, ch1, sk1, fphdc around next dc, ch1, repeat* to end of row, hdc into last st.

Row 2:

Ch2, *Sk1, fphdc around next dc, ch1, sk1, fphdc around next, ch1, sk1, 5dc into ch1 sp (between fphdcs), repeat* to end of row, hdc into last st.

Repeat rows 1 and 2, until your piece reaches 50" or your desired height.
