Use any yarn with the recommended hook. This project was created using scraps for Luck of the Draw 13 as a 40 inch square. Be playful with your color combinations. Solids on the spike segments show the texture best. We are working between clusters throughout most of this pattern.

Remember to HAVE FUN!!!!

slst= slip stitch ch= chain sc= single crochet hdc= half double crochet hdc corner= 3hdc ch2 3hdc dc= double crochet Granny cluster= 3dc in the same stitch Granny corner= 3dc ch2 3dc in corners

Extended Double Crochet Spike is worked in front of the work or a treble can be used.

spkcl= spike cluster- dc between clusters of previous round, extended dc spike in 2nd dc of cluster below working in front of your work LOOSELY, dc between.







Feel free to play with the color changes

Start with main color for LOTD13

Ch4 slst in 1st chain to create a ring.

- 1. ch3 2dc ch2, Granny Cluster ch2, Granny Cluster ch2, Granny Cluster, ch1 sc in ch3
- 2. ch3 2dc, Granny Corner in 3 remaining corners, 3 dc ch1 sc in ch3

Change color for LOTD13 to start week 1- Spike

- 3. ch2 2hdc, (spkcl, hdc corner) on 3 remaining sides, 3hdc ch1 sc in ch2
- 4. Repeat 3
- 5. Repeat 3

Change to main color for LOTD13- Granny

- 6. ch3 2dc, (Granny Cluster between all, Granny corner) on 3 remaining sides, 3dc ch1 sc in ch 3
- 7. Repeat 6
- 8. Repeat 6
- 9. Repeat 6

Change color for LOTD13 new week- Spike

- 10. Repeat 3
- 11. Repeat 3
- 12. Repeat 3

Repeat segments are 3 rounds of Spike, 4 rounds of Granny. You can end on any stitch segment. Continue the repeat until desired length is reached. For LOTD13 work 4 inches a week On week 9/10 we will add the border.

Boarder Options:

Mock Picot-

Ch1 or standing sc 2sc ch2 3sc in corners, sc in next 3 stitches, 1sc between (skip to the spike sc ch3 sc ch 2) repeat across, sc between, sc in last 3) repeat around, ch3 slst into ch1 or standing sc





Spike Picot- Ch1 or standing sc 2sc ch2 3sc in corners, sc in next 3 stitches, (2dc between, extended dc spike, ch3 slst into 1st ch, 2 dc between, sc between next repeat across, sc in last 3 stitches, sc ch3 sc in corner), repeat on remaining 3 sides. Ch 2 slst in ch1.
