In 2020, when world events postponed the delivery of over 32,000 blue hats I made a commitment to myself to make 100 blue hats for 2021. October 2020 I began a call to arms to my fellow creators and started #bluehatsforjax. Each month creators would hashtag pics of their blue hat makes. At the end of the month I put all the entries on a prize wheel and select someone to receive a gift. A few months ago I started giving a shipping blessing as well.

July 2021 will be the finale for my challenges. At the time of writing this pattern my challenges created 488 hats. I am overjoyed!







Stitches used:

ch- chain

slst-slip stitch

dc- double

fpdc- front post double

blhdc- back loop half double

Ddc- drop double. Dc in the front loop of the hdc from the round before



sc2tog- single 2 together. Insert hook draw up loop insert hook into next stitch draw up another loop draw through 3 to close. Begin each stitch sequence in the same stitch as just completed. Should not cause a decrease.





I used a 4 weight and an I hook for a loose large adult size.

If you want a snugger beanie use an H hook

ch 4, join

R1- ch1, 10 dc in ring, (carry along end for cinching center closed after join), slst into first dc to join (10 stitches)

R2- ch1, (dc, fpdc in same), repeat to end, slst into first dc to join (20 stitches)

R3- ch1, (dc 2, fpdc), repeat to end, join (30 stitches)

R4- ch1, (dc 3, fpdc) repeat to end, join (40 stitches)

R5- ch1, (dc 4, fpdc) repeat to end, join (50 stitches)

R6- ch1, (dc 5, fpdc) repeat to end, join (60 stitches) no more increasing

R7- ch1, blsc in first, blsc in every remaining stitch, slst into the bl if the first sc

R8- ch1, blsc in first, blsc in every remaining stitch, slst into the both loops of the 1st sc

R9- ch1 hdc in same, hdc in each, join (60)

R10-11- ch1 blhdc in same, blhdc in each, join (60)

R12- ch1 hdc in same, (Ddc, hdc) repeat to end, join (60)

R13- ch1, blhdc in same, blhdc in all, join (60)

R14-19- repeat 11-12 (60)

R20-23- repeat R12 (60)

R24- ch1, sc2tog in every stitch, join (60)

R25- ch1 (slst,ch1), repeat tie off

Add a pom or tassel(s) to decorate. You can also add your favorite tag.

Sew in ends
