

Textured Cabin Throw

This pattern was written for Camp Boggy Creek so the dimensions are within their parameters. If you would like to make it larger, just increase your foundation row.

Materials:

Aprox. 1,200 yds of 4wt yarn (or whatever yarn you would like)

6mm crochet hook (or whatever size hook goes with your yarn wt)

Scissors

Darning needle

Foundation Row

*Ch 3, dc in 1st ch

Repeat * until you reach 40" (the amount will vary depending on your yarn choice, tension and hook size)

Row 1 - ch2 (counts as a hdc here and throughout) turn, 3dc in ch3 loop across, hdc in last ch

Row 2 - ch2 turn, dc in 1st dc, fptc in 2nd dc, dc in 3rd dc, hdc in top of ch2

Row 3 - ch2 turn, *3dc in fptc, repeat* across, hdc in last st

From this point you will repeat rows 2 and 3, (ending in row 2) until your piece measures 50"

Textured Cabin Squared

Materials:

Approx. 3,000 yds. Of 4wt. Yarn and the corresponding hook for the yarn

Darning needle

Scissors

Ch. 4 or Magic Ring

Rnd 1 - ch3 (counts as a dc. here and throughout) 2dc, ch2 3dc, ch2 3dc 3 times, join to beginning ch3

Rnd 2 - turn, ch3 2dc, *dc fptrc dc, 3dc ch2 3dc in corner, repeat * for 3 other sides, 3dc ch2 join to top of ch3

Rnd 3 - turn, ch3 2dc, (skip to the fptrc here and throughout) *3dc in top of fptrc, 3dc ch2 3dc in corner, repeat * for 3 other sides, 3dc ch2 join to top of ch3

Rnd 4 - Rnd ? Repeat rnds 2 and 3 until you reach desired dimensions
