Grannie's Bloomers

This pattern was written for Camp Boggy Creek so the dimensions are within their parameters. If you would like to make it larger, just increase your foundation row.

Materials:

Approx. 1,800 yds of 4 wt yarn (or whatever yarn you would like) 6mm crochet hook (or whatever size hook goes with your yarn wt) Scissors
Darning needle

Stitch Description:

Ch chain

DC double crochet

PC popcorn

DCCL double crochet cluster

Special Stitches:

Popcorn - 4 dc in same space. Remove hook and pickup 1st dc. With 1st dc on hook pickup loop from 4th dc. Pull through both to form popcorn.

Double Crochet Cluster - 3 dc together in same space. Yarn over insert hook, yarn over pull through 2 loops, hold. Do this 2 more times then yarn over and pull through all loops on hook.

Ch 5, slst to 1st ch to for a loop

Rnd 1 - Ch3 (counts as a dc here and throughout). Dc 3 and form your 1st PC. ch2, PC 3 times. Join to top of 1st PC

Rnd 2 - Ch3 DC3 in corner and form PC, ch2 PC ch2 PC in next ch sp 3 times, PC into last ch sp (where you placed your 1st PC) ch2 join to top of 1st PC.

Rnd 3 - ch3 DC2 in corner sp. DC3 in next ch sp. DC3 ch2 DC3 into corner sp. Repeat around finishing with DC3 ch2 DC forming your last corner.

Rnd 4 - Repeat Rnd 3

Rnd 5 - Ch3 as part of your 1st DCCL. Ch2 DCCL into all ch sps across. DCCL ch2 DCCL in corner. Repeat around finishing with DCCL ch2 join to 1st DCCL to form your last corner.

Rnd 6 - Repeat Rnd 5

For all remaining rnds, repeat rnds 1,2,3,4,5 and 6 until your blanket reaches desired size.

Border Rnd 1 - 3DC into corner, 2DC in each ch sp, DC in DCCL across. 3DC ch2 3DC into corner. Repeat around finishing with 3DC ch2 forming your last corner.

Border Rnd 2 - 7DC into corner, Sk2, sc in next st, sk2 5DC in next. Repeat across, 7DC into corner, Repeat until you reach last corner and join to top of 1st DC.
