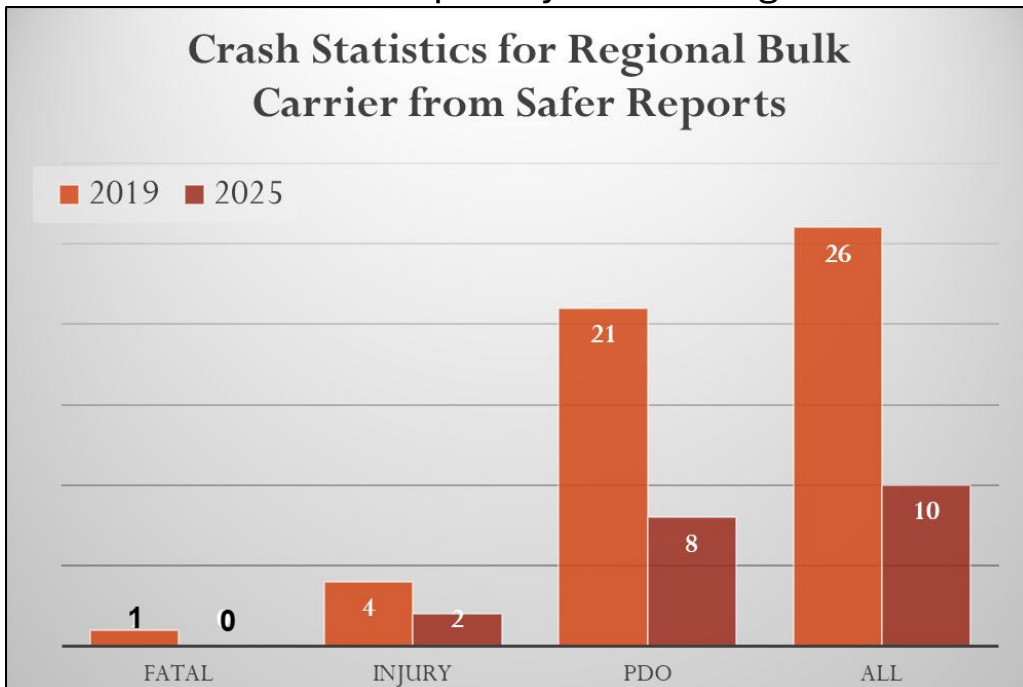
## Has CMV Driver Safety Improved?

After a decade of worsening statistics, FMCSA data for heavy trucks in the last five years has shown modest improvement,

Heavy Trucks	2019	2024	Change
Total Crashes	164,957	154,618	Down 6.2%
Fatalities	5,088	4,528	Down 11.0%
Injuries	81,404	73,393	Down 9.8%

## Are there examples of companies that have outperformed that national averages?

Here is an example of a regional bulk hauler that has cut the number of crashes on the Safer Report by an amazing **50%**.



Note: Fleet miles were also down 23%. But the total crashes normalized per 100 mm shows a 50% improvement.

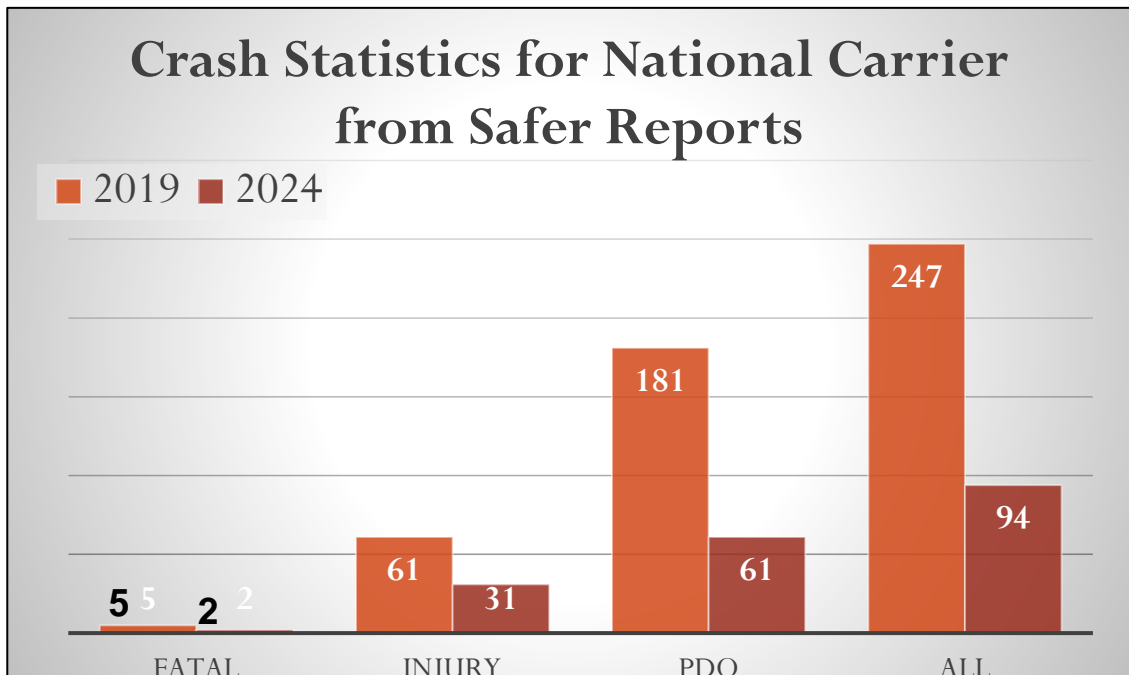
