

For those students who long for more we offer our Elite Streams, which include additional technical classes, focusing on ballet and body conditioning.

Examinations

Ballet Students are encouraged to participate in our Annual Ballet Examinations. The British Ballet Syllabus is taught in each graded ballet class. Examinations are held in August at the Studio. There is a fee to sit the exam and there are also additional uniform requirements.

Syllabus Training & Workshops

At LWSOD, we offer The Glenwood Tap, Acrobatic Dance Association, and IDT Global (International Dance Technique) Syllabi in all our classes, across all age groups.

Mid Year Cabaret Performance

A highlight every year is our Mid Year Cabaret Performance. Held at Melrose Receptions Centre in Tullamarine in July each year. Students perform in our Floorshow, while parents, family and friends sit back relax and enjoy a 3 course meal. Tickets for our Mid Year Cabaret go on Sale in May each year.

Musical Theatre Showcase

Featuring performances from our private singing students in solo, duo and ensemble pieces, along with exciting numbers from our Musical Theatre classes and dancers, this showcase brings to life some of our favourite and most loved musicals. An unforgettable evening of talent, storytelling and performance. Held in August/September each year.

End of Year Showcase

Our End of Year Showcase is held in the Yan Yean Theatre at Plenty Ranges Arts and Convention Centre in South Morang in December each year. It is very exciting for our Students to perform on the big stage, under lights in their costumes for their parents, families and friends. Tickets for our End of Year Showcase go on Sale in November each year.

Competition Teams

We encourage all Students to audition for our Competition Teams. Competition Teams are broken down by ages – Minis (under 8), Juniors (under 10), Sub-Inters (under 13) and Senior (under 17).

Auditions are held at the beginning of each new year. Teams usually attend three to four Competitions for Groups. Soloists are encouraged to attend as many Competitions as they desire. Additional costs are charged for Competition Teams and entry fees for Competitions. All information is distributed at the beginning of each year.

Zodiac Dance Crew

In 2019 we introduced our very own Hip Hop Crew "Zodiac Dance Crew". This Crew was established for Students wishing to pursue and perfect the art of Hip Hop Dancing. The Crew will compete at various competitions locally and interstate. Crew Members are Auditioned annually.

Interstate Trips

Our Competition Teams regularly travel to Interstate National Finals. Teams are required to qualify at local Regional Competitions in order to compete at the National Finals. Students can compete as Soloists or in Groups. It is not compulsory for all Team Members to attend. An Expression of Interest is offered each year for those interested in attending National Finals. Our Teams have travelled to Queensland, Perth, Sydney, Adelaide and Canberra to compete in the past.



Our Sub-Inter Classes are suited to children aged 9-11 years. At this level our styles are offered as 45 minute classes. Students continue to further develop their basic technique in Ballet, Jazz and Tap and also in Hip Hop and Acrobatics and Musical Theatre.

In conjunction with our basic technique classes in all styles Students are offered Lyrical, Conditioning and Technique classes to enhance the foundations they have already gained.

- **Team LWSOD** - classes concentrate on learning and rehearsing routines for competing.
- **Private Lessons** - available for students wishing to learn solos for competing or wish to focus on a particular technique to help them improve their dancing
- **Elite Extension Class** - focusses on building strength and flexibility to enhance kicks, turns and jumps.
- **Zodiac Dance Crew** - Our Crew was established for Students wishing to pursue and perfect the art of Hip Hop Dancing.
- **Set The Scene** - a dynamic and inspiring Acting Program designed for children as young as 5 years old, to adults.

Class duration is 45 minutes, Extension & Team LWSOD Training are 1.5hr and Zodiac Dance Crew Training is 1 hr.

Fees are based on a 10 week Term. Term Dates run in line with School Holidays

All classes are invoiced at an hourly rate of \$19.00. Invoices are emailed at the commencement of each new term. Payments can be made by Cash, EFTPOS, Bank Transfer. Ezidebit Payment Plans are also available.

All Uniform items can be purchased and ordered from the Studio.

Students grooming is extremely important. Hair must be pulled back, neatly into a ponytail, off the face to avoid distraction to the student and teacher. Hair must be in bun for all classes, except Hip Hop.

No baggy clothing, hoodies, tracksuit pants, clothing under dancewear or leggings/tights over dancewear is permitted to be worn in class.

All Studios are fitted with Air conditioners for heating and cooling and are set to a suitable temperature for dancing.

Correct footwear must be worn in all classes to ensure the Students are learning the correct techniques.

Sub-Inter Costume Requirements

Costumes for our Annual Performances are hired to each student for wear for the entire year. Costume Hire Fees start at \$50 per costume and are invoiced at the beginning of Term 2. Parents are not required to sew or alter costumes. You are required to purchase undergarments, crop tops, tights and footwear as required.
