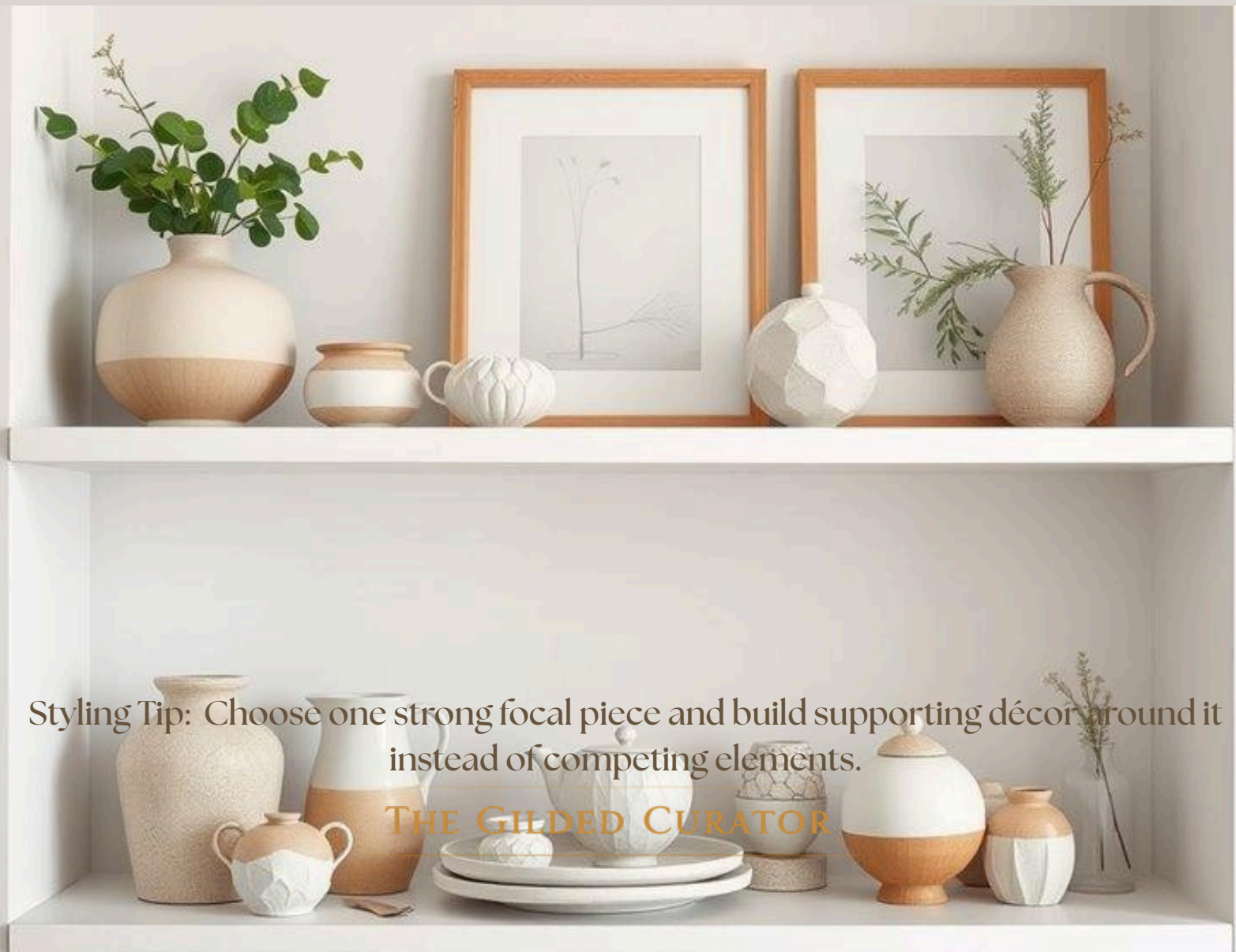
Create Beautiful Focal Points

10 Styling Ideas To Try Today
